Did you know?

More than 40 members of the Knights of Columbus members were killed on September 11, 2011. The Knights of Columbus were one of the first organizations to offer relief to families of fallen police, firefighters and emergency personnel - emergency within two days of the September 11 terrorist attacks. \$1.49 million in immediate aid were provided to 419 relatives of fallen personnel through the Knights' Heroes Fund, which distributed checks to family members - regardless of religious affiliation.

The Knights have taken the lead in helping the country to remember the day in a prayerful way. In 2004, the Knights of Columbus dedicated September 11 as the World Day of Prayer for Peace.
