**1st Reading – Amos 6:1A, 4-7**


**Responsorial Psalm – Psalms 146:7, 8-9, 9-10**

**2nd Reading – 1 Timothy 6:11-16**

**Gospel – Luke 16:19-31**

Jesus said to the Pharisees: "There was a rich man who dressed in purple garments and fine linen and dined sumptuously each day. And lying at his door was a poor man named Lazarus, covered with sores, who would gladly have eaten his fill of the scraps that fell from the rich man's table. Dogs even used to come and lick his sores. When the poor man died, he was carried away by angels to the bosom of Abraham. The rich man also died and was buried, and from the netherworld, where he was in torment, he raised his eyes and saw Abraham far off and Lazarus at his side. And he cried out, 'Father Abraham, have pity on me. Send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, for I am suffering torment in these flames.' Abraham replied, 'My child, remember that you received what was good during your lifetime while Lazarus likewise



received what was bad; but now he is comforted here, whereas you are tormented. Moreover, between us and you a great chasm is established to prevent anyone from crossing who might wish to go from our side to yours or from your side to ours.' He said, 'Then I beg you, father, send him to my father's house, for I have five brothers, so that he may warn them, lest they too come to this place of torment.' But Abraham replied, 'They have Moses and the prophets. Let them listen to them.' He said, 'Oh no, father Abraham, but if someone from the dead goes to them, they will repent.' Then Abraham said, 'If they will not listen to Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded if someone should rise from the dead.'"


## My Dear Parish Family,

As you've read in past bulletin letters and seen for yourselves, this summer was a busy one for capital projects. The summer began with the installation of new doors in all the entrances of the school building. They look great and add a new layer of security to our school building.

Next, the paving and painting project fixed the church steps and replaced the sidewalk in front of the church and behind the rectory driveway. We were also able to restore the façade and eaves of the church that were water damaged and peeling. This gave the church building a nice "face lift" as we prepare to celebrate our 100th Anniversary.

The final project for the summer began this past week: a new floor for the school gym/parish hall. The present floor is the original tile floor that was installed in 1962. It has served the school and parish well over the last 60 years. The gym is the major meeting place for the parish along with also being the school auditorium and cafeteria. We want to make sure it will serve us well for another 60 years. This new floor installation includes a new floor for the gym, the gym entryway, the gym kitchen, and the resource room. This project will be completed during this coming week and our students, our sports teams, and our staff are very excited!




