

Pastor's Note...

All of us have, at least to some extent, been hurt by the evil of the sexual abuse of minors by clergy. Although the Catholic bishops of the United States have taken significant steps to address this sinful behavior, the effects remain and will continue for the foreseeable future.

Most parish priests, myself included, have addressed this terrible reality both in writing and in homilies. I regret that the need to do so exists.

Recently Bishop Robert Barron published <u>Letter</u> to a <u>Suffering Church</u>. This short, slightly over 100

might benefit from reading <u>Letter to a Suffering</u>
<u>Church</u>. I need to caution that some portions of this book are very difficult to read. The word "disgusting" is not strong enough to describe some of what happened to the victims.

Let me conclude by noting that I hope all of us pray for everyone harmed by the wicked behavior of some priests and the cover up of that behavior by some bishops. Especially let us pray for the direct victims of that abuse.





St. Joseph, Lebanon and St. Mary, Frankfort

In the draft Deanery & Pastorate Modeling Profile, the parishes of St. Joseph in Lebanon and St. Alphonsus in Zionsville had been grouped together. We received feedback during the consultative period following the June Deanery presentations that suggested we consider the alternative grouping of St. Joseph, Lebanon with St. Mary, Frankfort. After consideration of the feedback and dialog with the parishes, it has been determined that this grouping would be a viable alternative. Thus, the new pastorate model now reflects this grouping.

It is anticipated that this grouping would have 2+ priests assigned to ensure the needs of both communities are met.
