Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

There will be a few adjustments to our Liturgies due to the Virus this year. Here are the basic changes.

On Palm Sunday there will be no procession with Palms. Ushers will be wearing gloves when they hand out the palms. The Chrism Mass will be celebrated on Tuesday at 11AM. It is for the priests only this year. On Holy Thursday there will be no Washing of the Feet. There will also be no solemn procession at the end of the liturgy. On Good Friday there will be no touching of the Cross at the Veneration. We will either genuflect or bow to the Cross. At the Easter Vigil only the Candidates and Catechumens will gather at the Fire. Everyone will not light a small candle as the Pascal Candle is brought in. Holy Water will be available in small bottles to take home if you would like some.

These basic changes are for this year only and are meant to safeguard everyone. It is so very wise of the Church to be very careful and not wanting to spread the Virus.

Todo el mundo no encenderá una pequeña vela mientras la Vela Pascal es traída. Holy Water estará disponible en botellas pequeñas para llevar a casa si quieres algunas.

Estos cambios básicos son sólo para este año y están destinados a salvaguardar a todos. Es muy sabio de la Iglesia tener mucho cuidado y no querer propagar el Virus.

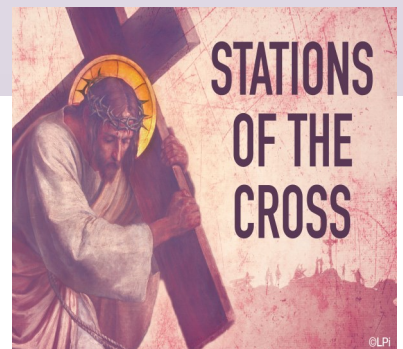

Fifth Sunday of Lent

First Reading: Jeremiah 31:31-34

"I will place my law within them and write it upon their hearts; I will be their God, and they shall be my people." "...I will forgive their evil doing and remember their sin no more."

Reflection Question: Do I believe these words of God? Do I believe that God does not remember my sin and evil doing?

Second Reading: Hebrews 5:7-9

Christ listened to his suffering, learned from it, and was made perfect.

Reflection Question: God does not want me to look for and assume more suffering in my life, but rather that I have the courage to see the roots of my true hurts, pains, losses, and sufferings. When I am able to identify the root of my own suffering, I have begun the path to forgiveness and healing.

Gospel: John 12:20-33

The grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies to produce fruit.

Discussion Question: What must die in my attitudes and actions so that new life might sprout forth from my heart? When I am troubled, do I ask God to save me? Do I face my fears trusting in God?

Action

- Reflect on the losses in your life: the death of a loved one; moving from one city to another; loss of youth and health; loss of employment; loss of a relationship, etc. How did I grow through these experiences and what did they teach me?
- Lent might be a good time for a spiritual retreat. Check out the Life's Healing Journey Ministry website at lhj.misacor-usa.org.
- As part of my Lenten journey, I might want to read some spiritual materials regarding Lent.
- I might want to make a sacrifice during Lent to contribute to the parish.

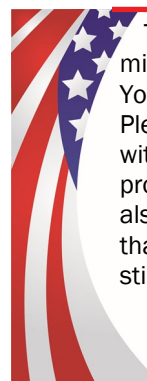
