

Pastor's Note...

Is there a moral obligation to receive a COVID-19 vaccination?

The Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith has noted recently that "vaccination is not, as a rule, a moral obligation and that, therefore, it must be voluntary. In any case, from the ethical point of view, the morality of vaccination depends not only on the duty to protect one's own health but also on the duty to pursue the common good." vi And it said that "in the absence of other means to stop or even prevent the epidemic" vaccination may promote the common good, "especially to protect the weakest and most exposed." For a vaccine to be effective in protecting society, most people need to be vaccinated in order to break the chain of disease transmission from person to person throughout the community. The Congregation also said that those who refuse to get vaccinated must do their utmost, by taking all the necessary precautions, to avoid "becoming vehicles for the transmission of the infectious agent. In particular, they must avoid any risk to the health of those who cannot be vaccinated for medical or other reasons, and who are the most vulnerable."

¿Existe la obligación moral de recibir una vacuna COVID-19?

La Congregación para la Doctrina de la Fe ha señalado recientemente que "la vacunación no es, por regla general, una obligación y que, por lo tanto, debe ser voluntario. En cualquier caso, desde el punto de vista ético, la moralidad vacunado depende no sólo del deber de proteger su propia salud, sino también del deber de bien común." vi Y dijo que "en ausencia de otros medios para detener o incluso prevenir la epidemia" la vacunación puede promover el bien común, "especialmente para proteger a los más débiles y expuestos". Para que una vacuna sea eficaz en la protección de la sociedad, la mayoría de las personas necesitan ser vacunadas para romper la cadena de transmisión de la enfermedad de persona a persona en toda la comunidad. La Congregación también dijo que aquellos que se niegan a vacunarse deben hacer todo lo posible, tomando todas las precauciones necesarias, para evitar "convertirse en vehículos para la transmisión del agente infeccioso. En particular, deben evitar cualquier riesgo para la salud de aquellos que no pueden ser vacunados por razones médicas u otras razones, y que son los más vulnerables."

Cemetery Decorations




All grave decorations must be in line with the monument foundation so as not to interfere with mowing or care of the grounds. Artificial flowers will be allowed
