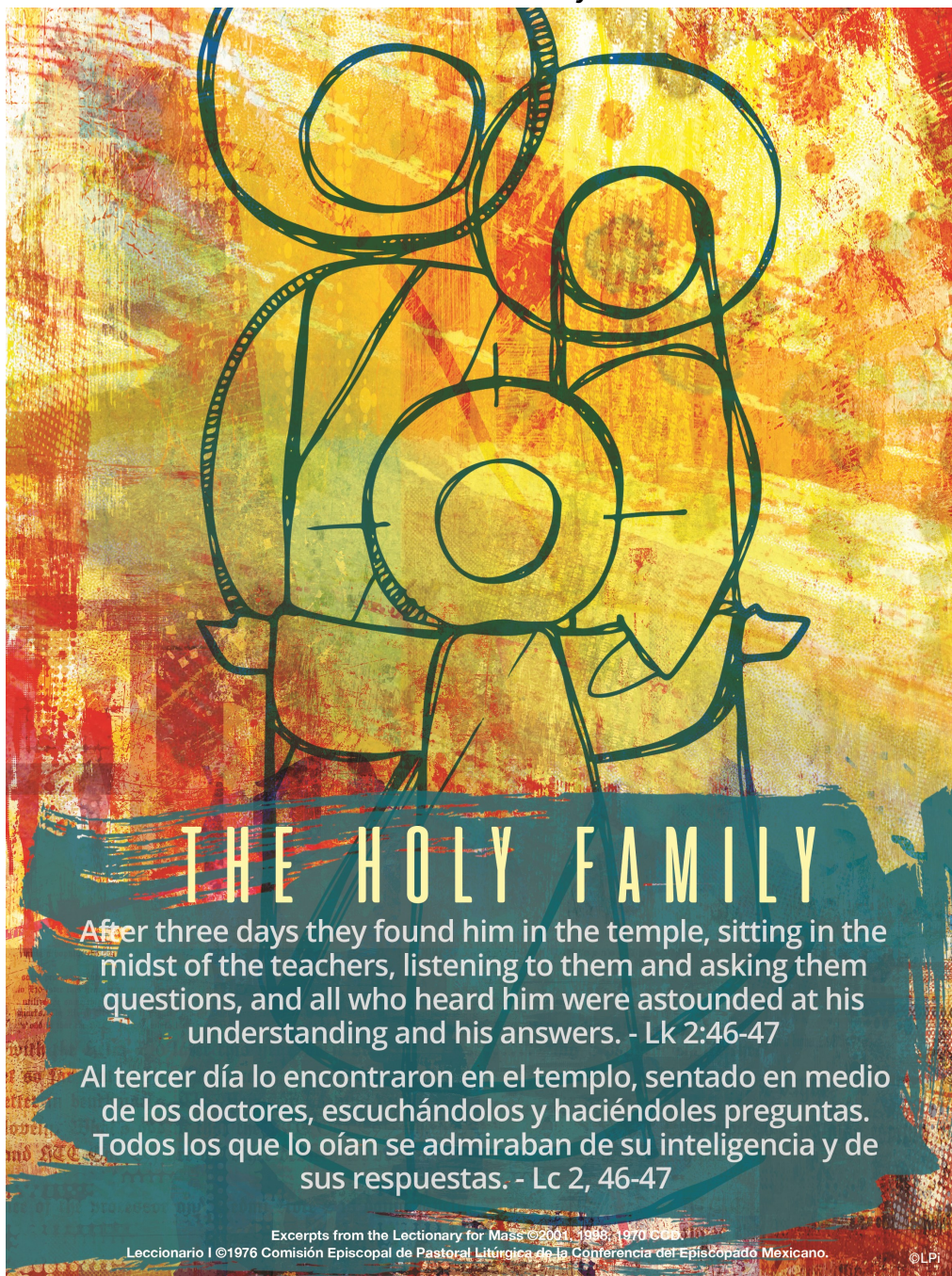

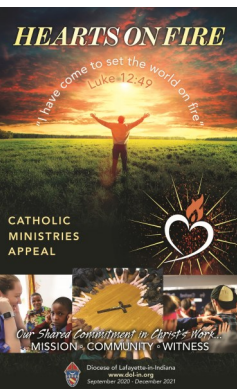

REPORT AN INCIDENT

How to report an incident of sexual abuse of a minor.

Who Should Make Reports:

- Victims of child sexual abuse by a person ministering on behalf of the Church.
- Persons with a suspicion that a child may be sexually abused by a person ministering on behalf of the Church.
- Persons concerned about violations about our Code of Conduct regarding appropriate behavior with children by any person ministering on behalf of the Church.

How to Make a Report:

If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse in the past or present day by clergy (priest or deacon) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

- Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556 or local law enforcement.
- Call Jackie Montrie M.A., LMFT, LMHC Victim Assistance Coordinator of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana at (765) 464-4988.
- Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.

If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse in the past or present day by someone working in a parish or school for the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana (such as religious sister or brother, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

- Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556 or local law enforcement
- Call our Ethics Hotline 855-375-6796, or go to dioceseoflafayetteinindiana.ethicspoint.com. OR
- Call Jeanne Lausten, Director of Human Resources at 765-269-4604.

Always contact local law enforcement of any incident of child abuse immediately.

Bishop, Vicar General, Moderator of the Curia and Chancellor

Bishop Doherty's role is to teach, sanctify and govern. "Helped by the priests, their co-workers, and by the deacons, the bishops have the duty of authentically teaching the faith, celebrating divine worship, above all the Eucharist, and guiding their Churches as true pastors. Their responsibility also includes concerns for all the Churches, with and under the pope" (Catechism of the Catholic Church no. 939). The bishop's role as a servant leader is to do everything in his power to unite the people of the diocese in heart and mind in the image and likeness of Jesus Christ, so they can continue in Christ's footsteps to build the reign of God on earth (Uniting in Heart Pastoral Planning Guide, 2015).

The vicar general/moderator of the curia as overall administrative coordinator is required, "...under the authority of the bishop to coordinate the exercise of administrative responsibilities and to see to it that other members of the curia duly fulfill the office entrusted to them" (Canon 473).

The chancellor is to see that all acts of the curia are gathered, arranged and safe-guarded in the archives of the curia, as well as secretary of the curia (Canon 483, §§ 1 and 3).

Obispo, Vicario General, Moderador de la Curia y Canciller

El papel del obispo Doherty es enseñar, santificar y gobernar. "Ayudados por los sacerdotes, sus colaboradores y los diáconos, los obispos tienen el deber de enseñar auténticamente la fe, celebrar el culto divino, sobre todo la Eucaristía, y guiar a sus Iglesias como verdaderos pastores. Su responsabilidad también incluye preocupaciones por todas las Iglesias, con y bajo el Papa" (Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica n. 939). El papel del obispo como líder servidor es hacer todo lo que esté a su alcance para unir de corazón y mente, a las personas de la diócesis, a imagen y semejanza de Jesucristo, para que, siguiéndolo como discípulos, contribuyan en la construcción del reino de Dios en la tierra (Guía de Planificación Pastoral *Uniting in Heart*, 2015).

Se requiere al Vicario General / Moderador de la Curia como coordinador administrativo general, "... bajo la autoridad del obispo para coordinar el ejercicio de las responsabilidades administrativas y velar por que otros miembros de la curia cumplan debidamente con el cargo que se les ha confiado" (Canon 473).

El Canciller velará por que todos los actos de la curia se recopilen, dispongan y custodien en los archivos de la curia, así como el secretario de la curia (Canon 483, §§ 1 y 3).
