Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

As you read this I will be in Oberammergau, Germany to attend the Passion Play. I am scheduled to see the play on July 24th.

The Passion Play was begun as a pledge from the community of Oberammergau. In 1633 the Plague had entered into the village of Oberammergau. Several people had died from the plague. The town met together and pledged that if they were saved from any further deaths they would have a Passion Play every ten years. After the community made its pledge not one single person died from the plague. Since making the pledge the community has kept its word. While there have been a few exceptions, the town of Oberammergau every ten years has put on an incredible Passion Play. It is a world event. This year they expect that a half million people will come to Oberammergau to view the Passion Play.

It is divided into twelve scenes. Scenes 1 to 6 form the first part, which begins in the afternoon. After a three-hour break, scenes 7 to 12 follow in the evening. To be an actor in the play a person must be a resident of Oberammergau.

Know that you will be in my prayers as I offer Mass in Oberammergau.

Mientras lees esto, estaré en Oberammergau, Alemania para asistir a la Obra de la Pasión. Estoy programado para ver la obra el 24 de julio.

La Obra de la Pasión se inició como una promesa de la comunidad de Oberammergau. En 1633 la peste había entrado en el pueblo de Oberammergau. Varias personas habían muerto a causa de la peste. La ciudad se reunió y prometió que si se salvaban de más muertes, tendrían una obra de teatro de la pasión cada diez años. Después de que la comunidad hizo su promesa, ni una sola persona murió de la peste. Desde que hizo la promesa, la comunidad ha cumplido su palabra. Si bien ha habido algunas excepciones, la ciudad de Oberammergau cada diez años ha realizado una increíble obra de la pasión. Es un evento mundial. Este año esperan que medio millón de personas vengan a Oberammergau para ver la Obra de la Pasión.

Se divide en doce escenas. Las escenas 1 a 6 forman la primera parte, que comienza por la tarde. Después de un descanso de tres horas, las escenas 7 a 12 siguen por la noche. Para ser actor en la obra una persona debe ser residente de Oberammergau.

Sepan que estarán en mis oraciones mientras ofrezco misa en Oberammergau.
