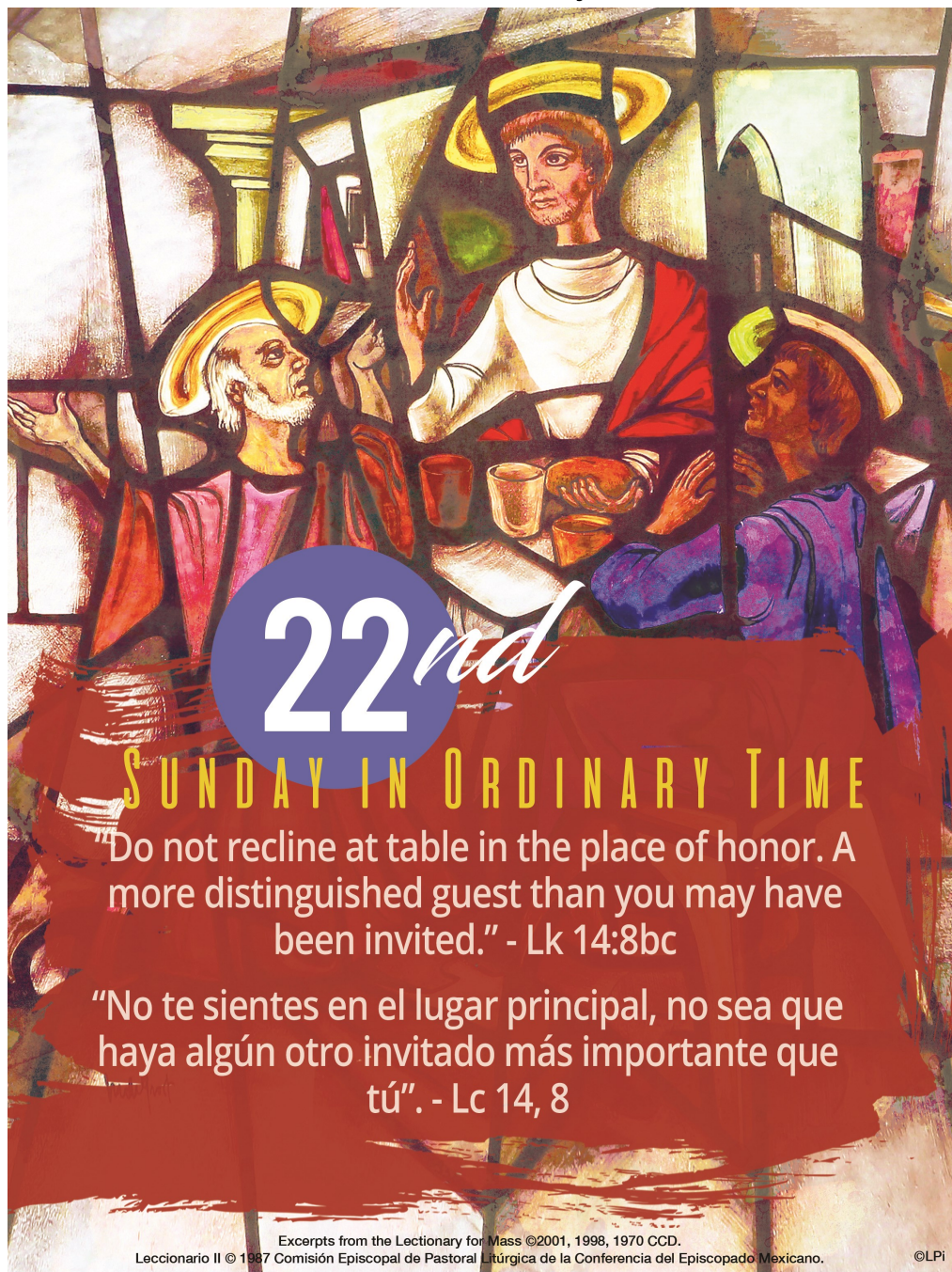

Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

Beginning Labor Day we will follow a different schedule for weekday Masses in the Pastorate. The new schedule is listed below. I have been consulting with parishioners for some time about this change. Often when a new pastor is appointed, he changes the daily schedule. I chose not to do that. I waited and looked over the situation and studied it for a long time. I consulted with many people and then decided what would be best for the pastorate. I believe this new schedule will be a help.

The biggest change in Lebanon involves not having weekday Saturday morning Mass. The new schedule is for Lebanon to have weekday Mass on the First Saturdays only. Many, many times the Saturday morning masses had to be cancelled. Cancelling them causes confusion and disruption to the parish. We will make an effort not to cancel the First Saturday Masses unless we have to.

The biggest change in Frankfort involves having a weekday Spanish Mass on Thursday evening. Thursday evening was chosen because of the large number of Hispanics who come to the prayer meeting on Thursday evenings. With 65% of the Frankfort Parish being Hispanic it makes sense that at least one of the weekday

Masses needs to be in Spanish.

I understand that change is hard for some people. I also understand that change can be a good thing. So please pray that everyone can accept this new schedule.

Queridos feligreses,

Comenzando el Día del Trabajo, seguiremos un horario diferente para las misas semanales en el Pastorado. El nuevo horario se enumera a continuación. He estado consultando con los feligreses durante algún tiempo sobre este cambio. Frecuentemente cuando se nombra un nuevo pastor, cambia el horario diario. Elegí no hacer eso. Esperé y miré la situación y la estudié durante mucho tiempo. Consulté con muchas personas y luego decidí qué sería lo mejor para el pastorado. Creo que este nuevo horario será una ayuda.

El mayor cambio en el Líbano implica no tener misa semanal los sábados por la mañana. El nuevo horario es que el Líbano tenga misa semanal solo los primeros sábados. Muchas, muchas veces las misas de los sábados por la mañana tuvieron que ser canceladas. Cancelarlos causa confusión y trastornos a la parroquia. Haremos un esfuerzo para no cancelar las

Misas del Primer Sábado a menos que tengamos que hacerlo.

El mayor cambio en Frankfort implica tener una misa semanal en español el jueves por la noche. El jueves por la noche fue elegido debido a la gran cantidad de hispanos que vienen a la reunión de oración los jueves por la noche. Con el 65% de la parroquia de Frankfort siendo hispana, tiene sentido que al menos una de las misas semanales tenga que ser en español.

Entiendo que el cambio es difícil para algunas personas. También entiendo que el cambio puede ser algo bueno. Así que por favor oren para que todos puedan aceptar este nuevo horario.

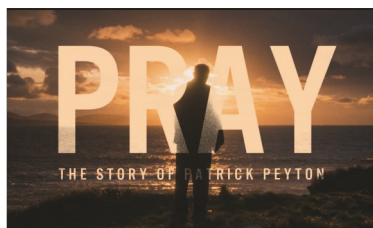
