Muchas gracias a cualquiera que pueda ayudarnos a apoyar el maravilloso ministerio de nuestro obispo.

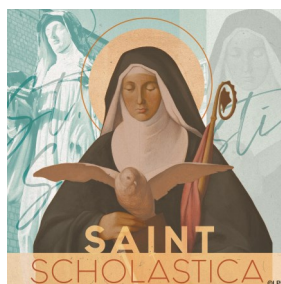

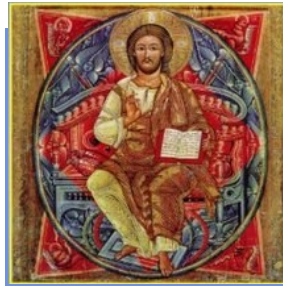

Dear Priests, Religious, and Laity,  
 Praised be Jesus Christ, now and forever!  
 I am grateful for the ongoing prayers you and your faithful communities provided as priests gathered at the St. Joseph Retreat & Conference Center on January 17-19. The men showed up and stayed for long days. Your prayers were felt.

We began our time together on the evening of January 17 with Vespers and dinner, providing us an opportunity for fellowship. Father Ted Dudzinski and I then gave introductory remarks and spiritual reflection. We both acknowledged the need for healing, and invoked the power of the Holy Spirit to guide our days; we moved right into a Holy Hour and concluded with Night Prayer.

The second day focused on listening to priests speak about their respective pastorates—what is going well, and where there are opportunities for improvement, with time for questions and clarifications. Day three was focused on collecting input from the priests to help us navigate a way forward.

Our current reality includes: fewer priests available, an imbalance of workload expectations and adjusting our diocesan level three-year plan. The “what” is not the only the question, but “how” we proceed must also be worked through.

All of our days together included quality time in prayer, the celebration of Mass, adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and serious dialogue about our recent experiences.

As I’ve mentioned before, there is no formula or set problem-solving structure to our current challenges. There are no easy answers. However, our discussions over the course of these three days certainly put us on a path forward. I am grateful and appreciative of the priests for their presence and commitment to the mission of Jesus Christ. I am thankful for the hard work and continued prayers of so many to make this assembly possible. Additional meetings among the priests will take place in February as our discernment process continues. I humbly ask that you please continue to hold all of this in prayer, as we seek healing and for guidance from the Holy Spirit on our path forward.



Queridos sacerdotes, religiosos y laicos,  
 ¡Alabado sea Jesucristo, ahora y siempre!  
 Estoy agradecido por las oraciones continuas que ustedes y sus comunidades fieles proporcionaron mientras los sacerdotes se reunieron en el Centro de Conferencias y Retiros St. Joseph del 17 al 19 de enero. Los hombres llegaron y se quedaron durante largos días. Sus oraciones se sintieron.

Comenzamos nuestro tiempo juntos la noche del 17 de enero con Vísperas y cena, brindándonos una oportunidad de compañerismo. Luego, el padre Ted Dudzinski y yo dimos unas palabras de introducción y una reflexión espiritual. Ambos reconocimos la necesidad de sanación e invocamos el poder del Espíritu Santo para guiar nuestros días; pasamos directamente a la Hora Santa y concluimos con la Oración Nocturna.

El segundo día se centró en escuchar a los sacerdotes hablar sobre sus respectivos pastorados: qué va bien y dónde hay oportunidades de mejora, con tiempo para preguntas y aclaraciones. El tercer día se centró en recopilar información de los sacerdotes para ayudarnos a navegar por el camino a seguir.

Nuestra realidad actual incluye: menos sacerdotes disponibles, un desequilibrio en las expectativas de carga de trabajo y el ajuste de nuestro plan de tres años a nivel diocesano. El “qué” no es la única pregunta, sino también hay que trabajar el “cómo” se procede. Todos nuestros días juntos incluyeron tiempo de calidad en oración, la celebración de la Misa, la adoración del Santísimo Sacramento y un diálogo serio sobre nuestras experiencias recientes.

Como mencioné antes, no existe una fórmula o una estructura establecida para resolver problemas para nuestros desafíos actuales. No hay respuestas fáciles. Sin embargo, nuestras discusiones en el transcurso de estos tres días ciertamente nos pusieron en el camino a seguir. Estoy agradecido y aprecio a los sacerdotes por su presencia y compromiso con la misión de Jesucristo. Estoy agradecido por el arduo trabajo y las continuas oraciones de tantos para hacer posible esta asamblea. Se llevarán a cabo reuniones adicionales entre los sacerdotes en febrero a medida que continúa nuestro proceso de discernimiento. Humildemente les pido que continúen manteniendo todo esto en oración, mientras buscamos la sanación y la guía del Espíritu Santo en nuestro camino a seguir.

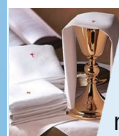

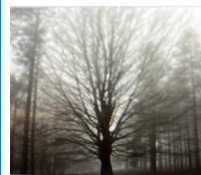
