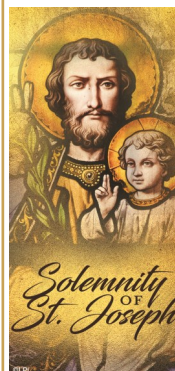

Dear Priests, Religious, and Laity,

Praised be Jesus Christ now and forever!

At the most recent meeting of the Presbyteral Council on March 7, the Uniting in Heart Core Team presented proposed adjustments to our Uniting in Heart 2030 diocesan pastoral plan. At the conclusion of that meeting, the Presbyteral Council recommended that the Uniting in Heart Core Team now share these proposals with all priests in active ministry for a final consultation.

This next priest assembly will take place on March 20, 2023, the Feast of St. Joseph. Because of this, I am asking your pastors to adjust Mass and sacramental schedules to accommodate this meeting, as it is incredibly important for everyone to be in attendance.

The presentation comes after much prayer, synthesizing of data, conversation and discernment. Not all feedback produced mutual consensus, but the Council and the Core Team have worked hard to account for priest feedback received, and formulated proposals that recommend a path forward.

The Core Team will present proposed adjustments to the presbyterate. Discussion time will follow. The goal remains to make necessary adjustments to the Uniting in Heart Pastoral Plan with enough time for the Clergy Ministry and Life Committee to work through June 2023 clergy assignments. This process has been thoughtful and honest and led by the Holy Spirit. I continue to ask for your prayers for our diocese, specifically seeking the guidance of the Holy Spirit on our path forward as we continue to build up Christ's Kingdom on Earth.

En la reunión más reciente del Consejo Presbiteral el 7 de marzo, el Equipo Central de *Uniting in Heart* presentó los ajustes propuestos a nuestro Plan Pastoral Diocesano *Uniting in Heart 2030*. Al final de esa reunión, el Consejo Presbiteral recomendó que el Equipo Central de *Uniting in Heart* ahora comparta estas propuestas con todos los sacerdotes en el ministerio activo para una consulta final.

La próxima asamblea sacerdotal tendrá lugar el 20 de marzo, 2023, fiesta de San José. Debido a esto, les pido a sus párrocos que ajusten los horarios de misas y sacramentos para adaptarse a esta reunión, ya que es increíblemente importante que todos asistan.

La presentación viene después de mucha oración, síntesis de datos, conversación y discernimiento. No todos los comentarios produjeron un consenso mutuo, pero el Consejo y el Equipo Central han trabajado arduamente para tomar en cuenta los comentarios de los sacerdotes recibidos y han formulado propuestas que recomiendan un camino a seguir.

El Equipo Central presentará los ajustes propuestos al presbiterio. Y luego seguirá un tiempo de discusión. El objetivo sigue siendo hacer los ajustes necesarios al Plan Pastoral *Uniting in Heart* con tiempo suficiente para que el Comité de Ministerio y Vida del Clero trabaje en las asignaciones de clérigos de junio, 2023.

Este proceso ha sido reflexivo y honesto y dirigido por el Espíritu Santo. Sigo pidiendo sus oraciones por nuestra diócesis, buscando específicamente la guía del Espíritu Santo en nuestro camino a seguir mientras continuamos construyendo el Reino de Cristo en la Tierra.

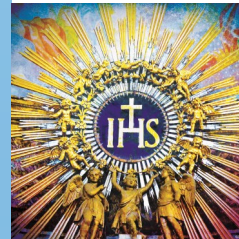
