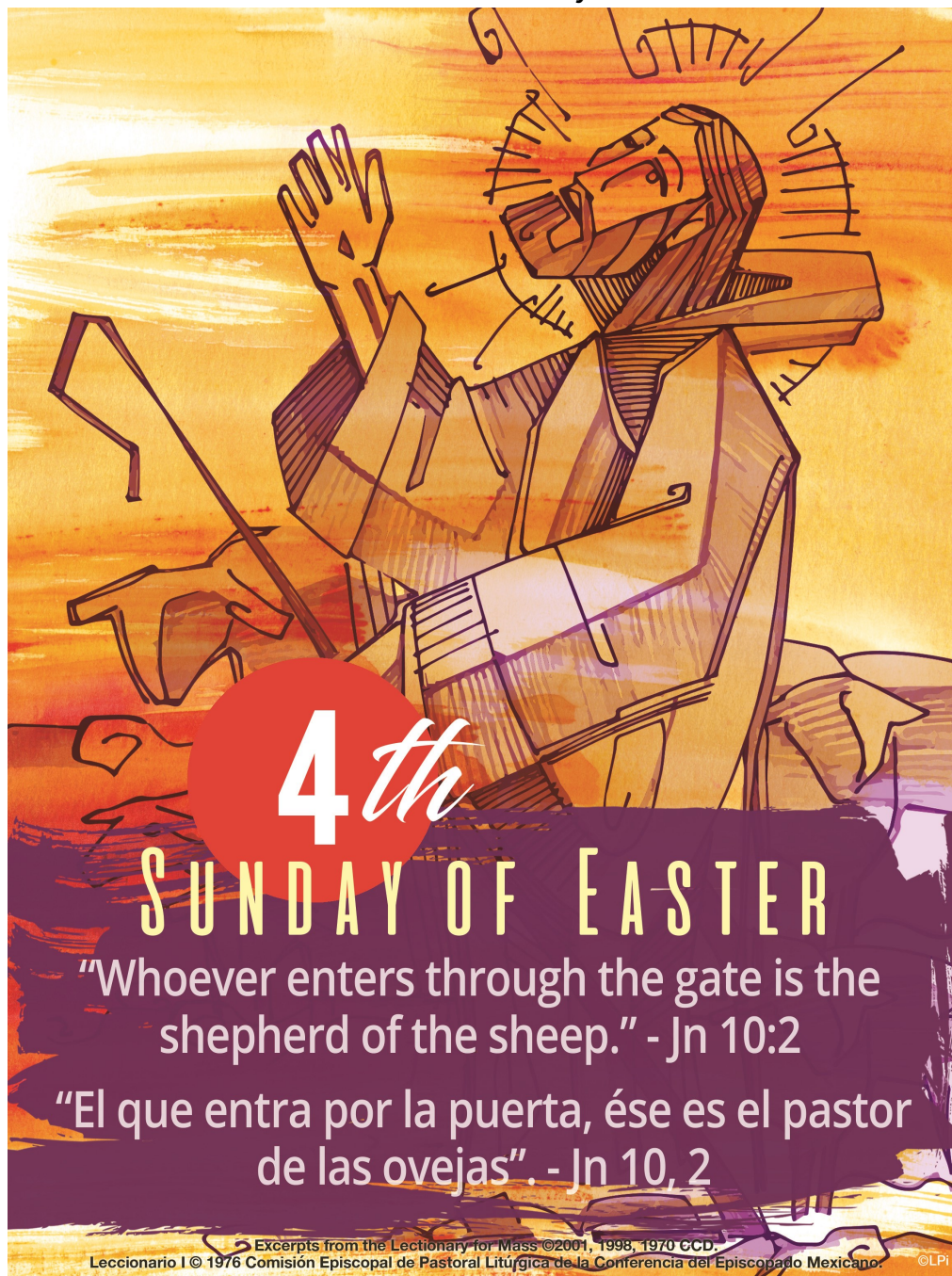

Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

On the weekend of June 10-11 we will begin distribution of the Blessed Sacrament under the form of the Blood of Christ at all Masses.

Jesus Christ clearly said "Take this and eat it" and then "Take this and drink." From the earliest days of the Church we understood that meant eating bread and drinking wine.

After Vatican II the Church restored this ancient practice so that everyone had the opportunity to do as Jesus instructed in the scripture. What a blessing it is for everyone to be able to receive both the Wine and the Bread.

While it is true that when we receive one form of the Blessed Sacrament we receive the fullness of the Eucharist, the scriptural emphases on both eating bread and drinking wine are clear.

There are some who will be overly concerned about passing on diseases. Obviously if a person is sick they should not take the cup. But generally speaking, Jesus was no dummy. He understood about passing on diseases and he still said Take and Eat and Take and Drink. I think we should simply trust him.

Estimados feligreses,

El fin de semana del 10 y 11 de junio comenzaremos la distribución del Santísimo Sacramento bajo la forma de la Sangre de Cristo en todas las misas.

Jesucristo dijo claramente: "Toma esto y cómelo" y luego "Toma esto y bebe". Desde los primeros días de la iglesia entendimos que eso significaba comer pan y beber vino.

Después del Vaticano II, la iglesia restauró esta antigua práctica para que todos tuvieran la oportunidad de hacer lo que Jesús instruyó en las Escrituras. Qué bendición es para todos poder recibir tanto el Vino como el Pan.

Si bien es cierto que cuando recibimos una forma del Santísimo Sacramento recibimos la plenitud de la Eucaristía, los énfasis bíblicos tanto en comer pan como en beber vino son claros.

Hay algunos que estarán demasiado preocupados por transmitir enfermedades. Obviamente, si una persona está enferma no debe tomar la copa. Pero en términos generales, Jesús no era un maniquí. Entendía acerca de transmitir enfermedades y todavía decía Toma y come y toma y bebe. Creo que simplemente deberíamos confiar en él.
