Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

Today I will continue with the distinctions the FDLC recently made. On page 35 of its document it states.....

EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

The Blessed Sacrament is exposed in a monstrance (or uncovered ciborium) for public veneration

A liturgical act; rites are composed and regulated by the Catholic Church

A public celebration that enables the faithful to perceive more clearly the relationship between the reserved sacrament and the celebration of Mass v In the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, a period of prayer, readings from the word of God, songs, and times of silent prayer

At least two people must be present when the Blessed sacrament is exposed

During lengthy periods of exposition, the Blessed Sacrament is reposed in the tabernacle when Mass is celebrated in the same space where exposition occurs v If interrupted because of too few worshippers the Blessed Sacrament is reposed in the tabernacle at times announced beforehand, however this reposition may not take place more than twice per day and at pre-determined times.

The period of exposition concludes with Benediction.

An example of this would have been a Forty Hours devotion. Notice that the church is now saying that at least two persons must be present whenever the Blessed Sacrament is exposed.

EXPOSICIÓN DEL SANTÍSIMO SACRAMENTO

El Santísimo Sacramento está expuesto en una custodia (o copón descubierto) para la veneración pública.

Un acto litúrgico; los ritos son compuestos y regulados por la Iglesia Católica

Una celebración pública que permite a los fieles percibir más claramente la relación entre el sacramento reservado y la celebración de la Misa v En presencia del Santísimo Sacramento, un período de oración, lecturas de la palabra de Dios, cantos y momentos de oración silenciosa

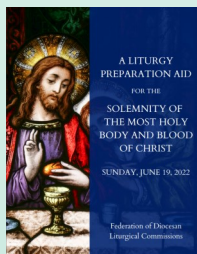
Al menos dos personas deben estar presentes cuando se expone el Santísimo Sacramento

Durante largos períodos de exposición, el Santísimo Sacramento descansa en el tabernáculo cuando la Misa se celebra en el mismo espacio donde ocurre la exposición. Si se interrumpe debido a muy pocos adoradores, el Santísimo Sacramento se deposita en el tabernáculo a veces anunciadas de antemano, sin embargo, esta reposición no puede tener lugar más de dos veces al día y en momentos predeterminados.

El período de exposición concluye con la Bendición.

Un ejemplo de esto habría sido un devocional de Cuarenta Horas. Note que la iglesia ahora está diciendo que al menos dos personas deben estar presentes cada vez que el Santísimo Sacramento es expuesto.

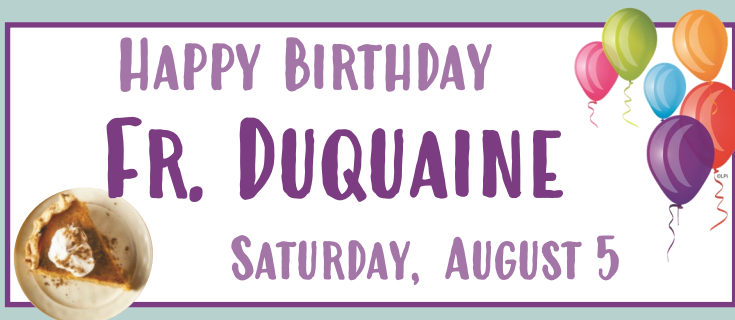

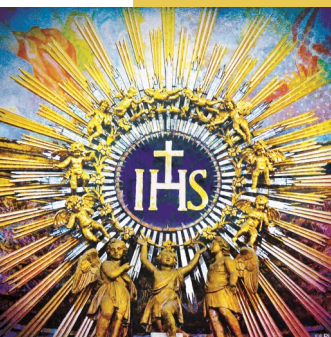

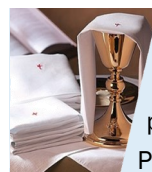
