Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

I want to ENCOURAGE the elderly and anyone who has any disability to consider sitting in the front of the church.

Sitting in the front of the church is best because a person can hear better and see better. Sight and sound are often difficult for those with disabilities. It is also easier for them to receive Holy Communion without asking someone to individually bring the Eucharist to them.

I hesitate to assign a particular pew for the handicapped because the situations are very different in the different masses in both parishes. I am simply asking that consideration be made to generally move to the front pew if at all possible.

Of course, it is a person's choice where they want to sit in the church. They may choose to sit wherever they want to do so.

My own personal experience of my mother is that when she was disabled, she wanted to fit in. She did not want to bring attention to herself. She moved to the front row of church so that she could hear and see better.

Quiero ANIMAR a los ancianos y a cualquier persona que tenga alguna discapacidad a considerar sentarse en el frente de la iglesia.

Sentarse en el frente de la iglesia es mejor porque una persona puede oír mejor y ver mejor. La vista y el sonido a menudo son difíciles para las personas con discapacidades. También es más fácil para ellos recibir la Sagrada Comunión sin pedirle a alguien que les traiga individualmente la Eucaristía.

Dudo en asignar un banco particular para los discapacitados porque las situaciones son muy diferentes en las diferentes misas en ambas parroquias. Simplemente pido que se considere la posibilidad de trasladarse en general al banco delantero si es posible.

Por supuesto, es la elección de una persona dónde quiere sentarse en la iglesia. Pueden elegir sentarse donde quieran hacerlo.

Mi propia experiencia personal de mi madre es que cuando estaba discapacitada, quería encajar. Ella no quería llamar la atención sobre sí misma. Se mudó a la primera fila de la iglesia para poder escuchar y ver mejor.

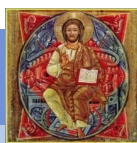
