One of the things the presenter spoke about at the Priests Retreat this past week was, the Priests as Brothers to one another. The retreat director made four points. It seems to me that his four points are just as applicable to parishioners as to Priests so I thought I would share them with everyone.

Four qualities of a good (Priest) or (Parishioner)

- 1. A good priest (Parishioner) needs to take time to get to know the other priests (parishioners). Knowing their hobbies, their likes and dislikes sets the stage for a good relationship.
- 2. A good priest (Parishioner) should be dependable and stable in their relationships with one another.
- 3. A good priest (Parishioner) should be able to express their individual opinions without threatening other people.
- 4. A good priest (Parishioner) should be able to share a common mission of the diocese (or of the parish).


