Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

This past week we celebrated All Saint's Day and All Soul's Day. Both of these days are a reminder that we have an obligation to pray for the Dead. The teaching of our Church is that when a person is in Purgatory they can do nothing themselves to help their situation. But, we can help them with our prayers. Fundamentally that is why we should pray for those in Purgatory, because we can help them.

The most perfect form of prayer in our Church is the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. While we pray for all the deceased at every Mass, the tradition of our Church is to offer the Mass for one particular person. It may be for a living person or it may be for a deceased person.

It makes good sense that in praying for the deceased we choose to offer the most perfect prayer we can for the person. That is why it is such a wonderful idea to offer Masses for the deceased.

November is often the time of the year when we are reminded to pray for the dead. For that reason, many people turn in their intentions for Masses during November. I would like to encourage you to do so.

Typically a Mass offering is \$10.00 but any amount may be offered. To have a Mass said in either parish the easiest method is to put the offering in the Sunday collection along with the person's name and the approximate date you would like to have the Mass offered. It is a good idea to also include some way to communicate with you (phone or email) so that once a date is decided you may be notified as to when it is.

Queridos feligreses,

La semana pasada celebramos el Día de Todos los Santos y el Día de los Fieles Difuntos. Ambos días son un recordatorio de que tenemos la obligación de orar por los muertos. La enseñanza de nuestra iglesia es que cuando una persona está en el Purgatorio, no puede hacer nada por sí misma para ayudar a su situación. Pero podemos ayudarlos con nuestras oraciones. Fundamentalmente es por eso que debemos orar por los que están en el Purgatorio, porque podemos ayudarlos.

La forma más perfecta de oración en nuestra Iglesia es el Santo Sacrificio de la Misa. Si bien rezamos por todos los difuntos en cada misa, la tradición de nuestra iglesia es ofrecer la misa por una persona en particular. Puede ser para una persona viva o puede ser para una persona fallecida.

Tiene sentido que al orar por el difunto elijamos ofrecer la oración más perfecta que podamos por la persona. Por eso es una idea tan maravillosa ofrecer misas por los difuntos.

Noviembre es a menudo la época del año en la que se nos recuerda que debemos orar por los muertos. Por esa razón, muchas personas entregan sus intenciones para las misas durante noviembre. Les animo a que lo hagan.

Por lo general, una ofrenda masiva es de \$10.00, pero se puede ofrecer cualquier cantidad. Para que se celebre una misa en cualquiera de las dos parroquias, el método más fácil es poner la ofrenda en la colecta dominical junto con el nombre de la persona y la fecha aproximada en la que le gustaría que se ofreciera la misa. Es una buena idea incluir también alguna forma de comunicarse con usted (teléfono o correo electrónico) para que una vez que se decida una fecha, se le notifique cuándo es.
