Dear Parishioners,

I would like to encourage you to take advantage of the 40 Hours Devotion in Frankfort this Sunday, Monday and Tuesday.

The devotion will begin Sunday after the 1:00 pm Spanish Mass. At the end of Mass the Eucharist will be put into a monstrance on the altar until the evening service at 6:00 pm. On Sunday evening we will celebrate Vespers prior to the formal Benediction. The Eucharist will then be reposed into the tabernacle until after the Monday morning Mass. Exposition will continue until 6:00 pm when we will have Benediction within the context of a Liturgy of the Word. The Eucharist will then be reposed in the tabernacle until Tuesday morning at 8:00 am. Exposition will take place until 6:00 pm when we will celebrate a closing Mass with a procession and Benediction.

I have asked Fr. Elliot Zak from Our Lady of Mount Carmel to preach each evening. He is extraordinarily talented and gifted. His preaching will be in both English and Spanish.

I hope you make use of this wonderful opportunity to grow closer to God.

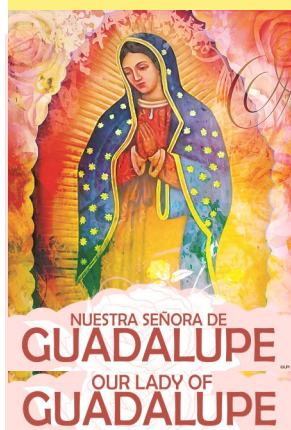

The **Annual Report** has been submitted to the National St. Vincent de
Paul Organization. We reported **56 Active and Associate**
members. Total receipts were \$73,335. Of this amount, \$40,690 was
from Grants and Community Foundation donations, \$9,120 from Fund-
raising efforts, and \$23,525 from parishioners and Svdp
members. 1,941 hours of service were given by both members and non-
members. The **emergency Food Pantry provided 514 bags of groceries**
valuing \$9,486. Non-food assistance/contacts: **389 personal contacts**
were made, representing 2,628 people assisted. **\$62,571 non-food**
assistance was provided to Clinton County neighbors, primarily for
housing assistance/eviction prevention and utilities. \$1,000 was shared
with the National St. Vincent de Paul for disaster relief. The
Conference thanks everyone for allowing us to steward your gifts to
struggling neighbors in Clinton County.

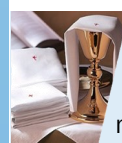
