Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

I thought it might be helpful to have a series on Jubilees. I hope that you find these helpful.

What is the Jubilee?

"Jubilee" is the name given to a particular year; the name comes from the instrument used to mark its launch. In this case, the instrument in question is the *yobel*, the ram's horn, used to proclaim the Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur). This (Jewish) holiday occurs every year, but it takes on special significance when it marks the beginning of a Jubilee year. We can find an early indication of it in the Bible: a Jubilee year was to be marked every 50 years, since this would be an "extra" year, one which would happen every seven weeks of seven years, i.e., every 49 years (cf. Leviticus 25:8-13). Even though it wasn't easy to organize, it was intended to be marked as a time to re-establish a proper relationship with God, with one another, and with all of creation, and involved the forgiveness of debts, the return of misappropriated land, and a fallow period for the fields.

Quoting the prophet Isaiah, the Gospel of Luke describes Jesus' mission in this way: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord," (Luke 4:18-19; cf. Isaiah 61:1-2). Jesus lives out these words in his daily life, in his encounters with others and in his relationships, all of which bring about liberation and conversion.

In 1300, Pope Boniface VIII called the first Jubilee, also known as a "Holy Year," since it is a time in which God's holiness transforms us. The frequency of Holy Years has changed over time: at first, they were celebrated every 100 years; later, in 1343 Pope Clement VI reduced the gap between Jubilees to every 50 years, and in 1470 Pope Paul II made it every 25 years. There have also been "extraordinary" Holy Years: for example, in 1933 Pope Pius XI chose to commemorate the 1900th anniversary of the Redemption, and in 2015 Pope Francis proclaimed the Year of Mercy as an extraordinary jubilee. The way in which Jubilee Years are marked has also changed through the centuries: originally the Holy Year consisted of a pilgrimage to the Roman Basilicas of St. Peter and St. Paul, later other signs were added, such as the Holy Door. By participating in the Holy Year, one is granted a plenary indulgence.


¿Qué es el Jubileo?

"Jubileo" es el nombre que se da a un año determinado; el nombre proviene del instrumento que se utiliza para marcar su lanzamiento. En este caso, el instrumento en cuestión es el *yobel*,

el cuerno de carnero, utilizado para proclamar el Día de la Expiación (Yom Kippur). Esta fiesta (judía) tiene lugar todos los años, pero adquiere un significado especial cuando marca el comienzo de un año de Jubileo. Podemos encontrar una indicación temprana de ello en la Biblia: un año de Jubileo debía marcarse cada 50 años, ya que éste sería un año "extra", uno que ocurriría cada siete semanas de siete años, es decir, cada 49 años (cf. Levítico 25:8-13). Aunque no era fácil de organizar, debía marcarse como un tiempo para restablecer una relación adecuada con Dios, con los demás y con toda la creación, e implicaba el perdón de las deudas, la devolución de las tierras malversadas y un periodo de barbecho para los campos.

Citando al profeta Isaías, el Evangelio de Lucas describe así la misión de Jesús: "El Espíritu del Señor está sobre mí, porque me ha ungido para anunciar la Buena Nueva a los pobres. Me ha enviado a proclamar la libertad a los cautivos y la vista a los ciegos, a dar la libertad a los oprimidos y a proclamar un año agradable al Señor" (Lc 4,18-19; cf. Is 61,1-2). Jesús vive estas palabras en su vida cotidiana, en sus encuentros con los demás y en sus relaciones, todo lo cual conlleva liberación y conversión.

En 1300, el Papa Bonifacio VIII convocó el primer Jubileo, también conocido como "Año Santo", ya que es un tiempo en el que la santidad de Dios nos transforma. La frecuencia de los Años Santos ha variado con el tiempo: al principio se celebraban cada 100 años; más tarde, en 1343, el Papa Clemente VI redujo el intervalo entre Jubileos a cada 50 años, y en 1470 el Papa Pablo II lo hizo cada 25 años. También ha habido Años Santos "extraordinarios": por ejemplo, en 1933 el Papa Pío XI eligió conmemorar el 1900 aniversario de la Redención, y en 2015 el Papa Francisco proclamó el Año de la Misericordia como jubileo extraordinario. El modo en que se marcan los Años Jubilares también ha cambiado a lo largo de los siglos: originalmente el Año Santo consistía en una peregrinación a las basílicas romanas de San Pedro y San Pablo, más tarde se añadieron otros signos, como la Puerta Santa. Al participar en el Año Santo, se obtiene la indulgencia plenaria.

WHAT

The Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana was awarded a Planning Grant of \$50,000 from Lilly Endowment Inc. "Hoosier Churches Initiative". This grant's purpose is to develop the case for an additional \$300,000 grant (also known as a capacity building grant) to address spiritual, pastoral, communication/technology, and leadership resources needed in our parishes.

WHY

We have been presented with an opportunity at the 5-year mark of Uniting in Heart to review, strengthen and improve the missionary work of our pastors and parishes to impact the hearts and needs of our current and future parishioners.

HOW

A brief survey will go out to all parishioners to check in about Uniting in Heart. These survey results will be collated by a grant project coordinator (funded through the planning grant). The coordinator will then lead discussions with pastors, priests, deacons, and parish staffs/councils to discern the resources needed to serve the mission of the Church at our parishes.

WHEN

Our additional grant proposal is due September 5, 2025 so survey input will be requested soon. A link, QR code will be requested to run in parish bulletins in Spanish and English, paper copies can be made available.

¿QUÉ?

La Diócesis de Lafayette, Indiana, ha sido premiada con una beca de planificación de 50,000 dólares por parte de la fundación Lilly Endowment "Iniciativa de las Iglesias Hoosier". Esta subvención (también conocida como subvención para ampliar espacios) tiene como objetivo presentar una propuesta que consiga añadir 300,000 dólares adicionales a la subvención que sean destinados a expansión de las áreas de dirección espiritual, área pastoral, área de comunicación, tecnología, y liderazgo en nuestras parroquias.

¿POR QUÉ?

Al cumplirse 5 años de Uniting in Heart, se nos ha presentado la oportunidad de revisar, fortalecer y mejorar la labor misionera de nuestros párrocos y parroquias para impactar mejor las necesidades de nuestros feligreses actuales y futuros.

¿CÓMO?

Se enviará una breve encuesta a todos los feligreses para que conozcan el estado de Uniting in Heart. Los resultados de la encuesta serán recopilados por un coordinador de proyecto (financiado a través de la beca de planificación).

Posteriormente, el coordinador tendrá conversaciones con párrocos, sacerdotes, diáconos, consejeros y personal de las parroquias para determinar los recursos necesarios que necesitan nuestras parroquias.

¿CUÁNDO?

Nuestra propuesta de aplicación de la subvención tiene que ser presentada el 5 septiembre de 2025, por lo que, en breve, se enviará una encuesta. Se proporcionará un link y código QR para ser publicado en los boletines parroquiales, tanto en español como en inglés. También habrá copias en papel disponibles.
