Pilgrimage

The jubilee calls for us to set out on a journey and to cross boundaries. When we travel, we do not only change place physically, but we also change ourselves. Hence, it is important to prepare ourselves well, to plan the route, and learn about the destination. In this sense, the Jubilee pilgrimage begins before the start of the journey itself: the starting point is the decision to set out. The etymology of the word "pilgrimage" is quite telling and has undergone little change in meaning over the years. The word comes from the Latin "*per ager*," meaning "across the fields," or perhaps from "*per eger*" meaning "border crossing": both possible origins point to the distinctive aspect of undertaking a journey.

In the Bible, Abraham is described as a person on a journey: "Go forth from your land, your relatives, and from your father's house" (Genesis 12:1). With these words Abraham begins his adventure, which ends in the Promised Land, where he is remembered as a "wandering Aramean" (Deuteronomy 26:5). Jesus' ministry can also be seen as a journey, from Galilee to the Holy City of Jerusalem ... "As the time drew near when Jesus would be taken up to heaven, he made up his mind and set out on his way to Jerusalem." (Luke 9:51). Christ himself calls His disciples to walk this road, and even today Christians are those who follow him and set out after Him.

The journey takes place gradually: there are various routes to choose from and places to discover; it is made up of particular sets of circumstances, moments of catechesis, sacred rites and liturgies. Along the way our traveling companions enrich us with new ways of understanding things and fresh perspectives. Contemplation of creation is also part of the journey and helps us to realize that care for creation "is an essential expression of our faith in God and our obedience to his will" (Pope Francis, Letter for the Jubilee 2025). Pilgrimage is an experience of conversion, of transforming one's very being to conform it to the holiness of God. During the pilgrimage, one also shares in the experience of those who, for various reasons, are forced to leave their homelands to seek a better life for themselves and their family.

Peregrinación

El jubileo nos invita a ponernos en camino y a cruzar fronteras. Cuando viajamos, no sólo cambiamos de lugar físicamente, sino que también

cambiamos nosotros mismos. Por eso es importante prepararse bien, planificar la ruta y conocer el destino. En este sentido, la peregrinación jubilar comienza antes del propio inicio del viaje: el punto de partida es la decisión de ponerse en camino. La etimología de la palabra "peregrinación" es bastante reveladora y ha sufrido pocos cambios de significado a lo largo de los años. La palabra procede del latín "*per ager*", que significa "a través de los campos", o quizá de "*per eger*", que significa "cruce de fronteras": ambos posibles orígenes apuntan al aspecto distintivo de emprender un viaje.

En la Biblia, Abraham es descrito como una persona en viaje: "Sal de tu tierra, de tus parientes y de la casa de tu padre" (Génesis 12:1). Con estas palabras Abraham comienza su aventura, que termina en la Tierra Prometida, donde se le recuerda como un "arameo errante" (Deuteronomio 26:5). El ministerio de Jesús también puede verse como un viaje, desde Galilea hasta la Ciudad Santa de Jerusalén... "Cuando se acercaba el momento en que Jesús iba a ser llevado al cielo, se decidió y se puso en camino hacia Jerusalén". (Lucas 9:51). Cristo mismo llama a sus discípulos a recorrer este camino, y aún hoy los cristianos son los que le siguen y se ponen en camino tras Él.

El viaje se realiza gradualmente: hay varias rutas que elegir y lugares que descubrir; está hecho de circunstancias particulares, momentos de catequesis, ritos sagrados y liturgias. A lo largo del camino, nuestros compañeros de viaje nos enriquecen con nuevas formas de entender las cosas y nuevas perspectivas. La contemplación de la creación también forma parte del viaje y nos ayuda a darnos cuenta de que el cuidado de la creación "es una expresión esencial de nuestra fe en Dios y de nuestra obediencia a su voluntad" (Papa Francisco, Carta para el Jubileo 2025). La peregrinación es una experiencia de conversión, de transformación del propio ser para conformarlo a la santidad de Dios. Durante la peregrinación, uno comparte también la experiencia de quienes, por diversas razones, se ven obligados a abandonar su tierra natal para buscar una vida mejor para sí mismos y para su familia.
