## Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

I thought it might be helpful to have a series on Jubilees. I hope that you find these helpful.

### Holy Door

From a symbolic viewpoint, the Holy Door takes on a special significance: it is the most powerful sign of the Jubilee, since the ultimate aim of the pilgrim is to pass through it. The opening of the door by the Pope constitutes the official beginning of the Holy Year. Originally, there was only one door, at the Basilica of St. John Lateran, which is the cathedral of the Bishop of Rome. Later, to allow as many pilgrims as possible to take part in the Jubilee experience, the other Roman Basilicas also opened their own holy doors.

In crossing the threshold of the Holy Door, the pilgrim is reminded of the passage from chapter 10 of St John's gospel: "I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture." Passing through the Holy Door expresses the decision to follow and be guided by Jesus, who is the Good Shepherd. The door is a passageway that ushers the pilgrim into the interior of a church. For the Christian community, a church is not only a sacred space, to be approached with respect, with appropriate behavior and dress code, but it is a symbol of the communion that binds every believer to Christ: it is a place of encounter and dialogue, of reconciliation and peace which awaits every pilgrim, the Church is essentially the place of the community of the faithful.

In Rome, this experience takes on a special significance because of the special links between the Eternal City and Saints Peter and Paul, the apostles who founded the Christian community in Rome and whose teachings and example are models for the universal Church. The tombs of Saints Peter and Paul are located in Rome, they were martyred here; and together with the catacombs, these sacred sites are places of continuous spiritual inspiration.

### Puerta Santa

Desde un punto de vista simbólico, la Puerta Santa adquiere un significado especial: es el signo más poderoso del Jubileo, ya que el objetivo último del peregrino es atravesarla. La apertura

de la puerta por el Papa constituye el inicio oficial del Año Santo. Originalmente, sólo había una puerta, en la Basílica de San Juan de Letrán, que es la catedral del Obispo de Roma. Posteriormente, para permitir que el mayor número posible de peregrinos participara en la experiencia jubilar, las demás basílicas romanas abrieron también sus propias puertas santas.

Al cruzar el umbral de la Puerta Santa, el peregrino recuerda el pasaje del capítulo 10 del Evangelio de San Juan: "Yo soy la puerta. Si alguien entra por mí, se salvará y entrará y saldrá y encontrará pastos". Pasar por la Puerta Santa expresa la decisión de seguir y dejarse guiar por Jesús, que es el Buen Pastor. La puerta es un pasadizo que conduce al peregrino al interior de una iglesia. Para la comunidad cristiana, una iglesia no es sólo un espacio sagrado, al que hay que acercarse con respeto, con un comportamiento y una vestimenta adecuados, sino que es un símbolo de la comunión que une a todo creyente con Cristo: es un lugar de encuentro y de diálogo, de reconciliación y de paz que espera a todo peregrino, la Iglesia es esencialmente el lugar de la comunidad de los fieles.

En Roma, esta experiencia adquiere un significado especial debido a los vínculos particulares entre la Ciudad Eterna y los Santos Pedro y Pablo, los apóstoles que fundaron la comunidad cristiana en Roma y cuyas enseñanzas y ejemplo son modelos para la Iglesia universal. En Roma se encuentran las tumbas de los Santos Pedro y Pablo, que fueron martirizados aquí; y junto con las catacumbas, estos lugares sagrados son lugares de continua inspiración espiritual.



## Director of Religious Education and Youth Ministry Assistant



FROM THE **UNITING IN HEART TEAM**

As was previously communicated, the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana was awarded a Planning Grant of \$50,000 from Lilly Endowment Inc. "Hoosier Churches Initiative". This grant's purpose is to develop the case for an additional \$300,000 grant (also known as a capacity building grant) to address spiritual, pastoral, communication/technology, and leadership resources needed in our parishes.
