

Lebanon Knights are having a joint effort.


A variety of coat sizes will be purchased, as well as hats and gloves, and these will be distributed to children in need of a warm winter coat.



## What is the Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus?



The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus began in 1670, when Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a Visitation nun, in France. Through these visions, He told her how He wished to be honored with the symbol of His Heart asking for the faithful to make amends for any wrong doing they had done, to frequently take Communion, and observe the Holy Hour.

In 1856 the devotion was added to the church calendar by Pope Pius XII. The church celebrates it every June as the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. It is celebrated on the third Friday after Pentecost. From this Solemnity came the First Friday observation. On every first Friday of each month we honor the precious Sacred Heart by participating in Mass. The Sacrament of Confession is requested and Holy Hour observance is practiced.

We can devote our hearts to His Sacred Heart everyday, also. There are many daily prayers that have been published for us to honor His Sacred Heart, that burns with desire for us to seek his infinite mercy. Let us be moved to love in return.

We, at St. Joseph, have a constant reminder to seek His overflowing infinite love. We have a reminder to devote our hearts to His. Observe the beautiful statue in our church,

depicting this infinite burning love and desire. Every time you are near the statue in our church, look up, gaze upon His Heart, and be reminded and thankful of His desire to have your heart united with His. Daily devotion to His Sacred Heart brings incredible contentment in our hearts and solace in our souls.
