

There have been some questions concerning the Church's perspective on cremation. The following is from the USCCB website. This article will be continued next week.



Cremation and the Order of Christian Funerals
From the Newsletter of the Committee on Divine Worship
(January 2012)

In April 1997, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments granted an indult for the United States to allow the diocesan bishop to permit the presence of the cremated remains of a body at a Funeral Mass. Later that year, the Congregation confirmed the special texts and ritual directives (Prot. n. 1589/96/L for both indult and texts), which were then published as an appendix to the Order of Christian Funerals. Frequently the Secretariat of Divine Worship receives requests for clarification or suggestions for best practices regarding the presence of cremated remains and funerals and their appropriate final disposition or committal.

The practice of cremation has grown and become more commonplace in the United States, and it is often presented as a more affordable alternative to traditional burial. What is often overlooked is the Church's teaching regarding the respect and honor due to the human body. The Order of Christian Funerals' Appendix on Cremation states: "Although cremation is now permitted by the Church, it does not enjoy the same value as burial of the body. The Church clearly prefers and urges that the body of the deceased be present for the funeral rites, since the presence of the human body better expresses the values which the Church affirms in those rites" (no. 413).

Ideally, if a family chooses cremation, the cremation would take place at some time after the Funeral Mass, so that there can be an opportunity for the Vigil for the Deceased in the presence of the body (during "visitation" or "viewing" at a church or funeral home). This allows for the appropriate reverence for the sacredness of the body at the Funeral Mass: sprinkling with holy water, the placing of the pall, and honoring it with incense. The Rite of Committal then takes place after cremation (see Appendix, nos. 418-421). Funeral homes offer several options in this case. One is the use of "cremation caskets," which is essentially a rental casket with a cardboard liner that is cremated with the body. Another is a complete casket that is cremated (this casket contains minimal amounts of non-combustible material such as metal handles or latches)

La cremación y el orden de los funerales cristianos
Del Boletín de la Comisión de Culto Divino (enero de 2012)

En abril de 1997, la Congregación para el Culto Divino y la Disciplina de los Sacramentos concedió un indulto para Estados Unidos que permitía al obispo diocesano autorizar la presencia de los restos incinerados de un cadáver en una Misa de exequias. Más tarde, ese mismo año, la Congregación confirmó los textos especiales y las directrices rituales (Prot. n. 1589/96/L tanto para el indulto como para los textos), que se publicaron como apéndice al Orden de las exequias cristianas. Con frecuencia, el Secretariado para el Culto Divino recibe peticiones de aclaración o sugerencias sobre las mejores prácticas en relación con la presencia de restos incinerados y las exequias y su adecuada disposición final o inhumación.

La práctica de la cremación se ha extendido y generalizado en Estados Unidos, y a menudo se presenta como una alternativa más asequible que el entierro tradicional. Lo que a menudo se pasa por alto es la enseñanza de la Iglesia sobre el respeto y el honor debidos al cuerpo humano. El Apéndice sobre la cremación de la Orden de Funerales Cristianos afirma: "Aunque la cremación está ahora permitida por la Iglesia, no goza del mismo valor que la inhumación del cuerpo. La Iglesia prefiere e insta claramente a que el cuerpo del difunto esté presente en los ritos funerarios, ya que la presencia del cuerpo humano expresa mejor los valores que la Iglesia afirma en esos ritos" (nº 413).

Idealmente, si una familia elige la cremación, la cremación tendría lugar en algún momento después de la Misa Funeral, para que pueda haber una oportunidad para la Vigilia por el Difunto en presencia del cuerpo (durante la "visitación" o "vista" en una iglesia o funeraria). Esto permite la reverencia apropiada a la sacralidad del cuerpo en la Misa Funeral: la aspersion con agua bendita, la colocación del féretro, y honrarlo con incienso. Después de la cremación tiene lugar el Rito del Entierro (véase el Apéndice, nn. 418-421). Las funerarias ofrecen varias opciones en este caso. Una es el uso de "ataúdes de cremación", que es esencialmente un ataúd de alquiler con un forro de cartón que se incinera con el cuerpo. Otra es un ataúd completo que se incinera (este ataúd contiene cantidades mínimas de material incombustible, como asas o cierres metálicos).



REPORT AN INCIDENT

How to report an incident of sexual abuse of a minor.

Who Should Make Reports:

- Victims of child sexual abuse by a person ministering on behalf of the Church.
- Persons with a suspicion that a child may be sexually abused by a person ministering on behalf of the Church.
- Persons concerned about violations about our Code of Conduct regarding appropriate behavior with children by any person ministering on behalf of the Church.

How to Make a Report:

If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse in the past or present day by clergy (priest or deacon) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

- Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556 or local law enforcement.
- Call Jackie Montrie M.A., LMFT, LMHC Victim Assistance Coordinator of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana at (765) 464-4988.
- Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.

If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse in the past or present day by someone working in a parish or school for the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana (such as religious sister or brother, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

- Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556 or local law enforcement
- Call our Ethics Hotline 855-375-6796, or go to dioceseoflafayetteinindiana.ethicspoint.com. OR
- Call Jeanne Lausten, Director of Human Resources at 765-269-4604.

Always contact local law enforcement of any incident of child abuse immediately.



2. Llame a Jackie Montrie M.A., LMFT, Coordinadora de Asistencia a Víctimas de LMHC de la Diócesis de Lafayette-en-Indiana al (765) 464-4988.
3. A partir de entonces, se llevará a cabo una investigación por, o en nombre de, la Diócesis de Lafayette-en-Indiana.

Si usted o alguien que conoce ha sido víctima de abuso sexual infantil en el pasado o en la actualidad por alguien que trabaja en una parroquia o escuela para la Iglesia Católica en la Diócesis de Lafayette-en-Indiana (como un hermano o hermana religiosa, empleado laico, voluntario laico, etc.) se le solicita que denuncie el incidente de la siguiente manera:

1. Haga una denuncia al Servicio de Protección Infantil llamando al 800-800-5556 o a la policía local.
2. Llame a nuestra Línea Directa de Ética 855-375-6796, o visite dioceseoflafayetteinindiana.ethicspoint.com. O
3. Llame a Jeanne Lausten, Directora de Recursos Humanos al 765-269-4604.

Siempre contacta a las autoridades locales de inmediato ante cualquier incidente de abuso infantil.




