Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

There have been some questions concerning the Church's perspective on cremation. The following is from the USCCB website. It is continued from last week.



Cremation and the Order of Christian Funerals
From the Newsletter of the Committee on Divine Worship
(January 2012)

When cremation takes place before the Funeral Mass, and the diocesan bishop permits the presence of cremated remains at the Funeral Mass, the Appendix provides adapted texts for the Sprinkling with Holy Water, the Dismissal for use at the Funeral Mass (or the Funeral Liturgy outside Mass), and the Committal of Cremated Remains. The introduction provides further specific details about how the funeral rites are adapted. In all, the rite notes:

The cremated remains of a body should be treated with the same respect given to the human body from which they come. This includes the use of a worthy vessel to contain the ashes, the manner in which they are carried, and the care and attention to appropriate placement and transport, and the final disposition. The cremated remains should be buried in a grave or entombed in a mausoleum or columbarium. The practice of scattering cremated remains on the sea, from the air, or on the ground, or keeping cremated remains on the home of a relative or friend of the deceased are not the reverent disposition that the Church requires. (no. 417)

For some families, the choice of cremation is based on financial hardship, so this choice often means also that there is no plan for committal or burial of the cremated remains. As a means of providing pastoral support and an acceptable respectful solution to the problem of uninterred cremated remains, one diocese offered on All Souls' Day in 2011 an opportunity for any family who desired it the interment of cremated remains. The diocese offered a Mass and committal service at one of its Catholic cemeteries and provided, free of charge, a common vault in a mausoleum for the interment of the cremated remains. The names of the deceased interred there were kept on file, though in this case they were not individually inscribed on the vault.

As cremation is chosen more frequently, there will be many who are unaware of the Church's teaching regarding this practice. It is important for bishops and pastors not only to catechize the faithful, but to collaborate with funeral directors in providing helpful and accurate information to families planning the funeral of loved ones. Offering opportunities to family members for the respectful burial of their loved ones, who were not interred after funeral services and cremation, would give effective witness to the importance of Christian burial and our belief in the resurrection. In all, pastors are encouraged to show pastoral sensitivity, especially to those for whom cremation is the only feasible choice (see Appendix, no. 415).

La cremación y el orden de los funerales cristianos
Del Boletín de la Comisión de Culto Divino (enero de 2012)

Cuando la cremación tiene lugar antes de la Misa de exequias, y el obispo diocesano permite la presencia de restos cremados en la Misa de exequias, el Apéndice proporciona textos adaptados para la aspersión con agua bendita, la despedida para su uso en la Misa de exequias (o la liturgia de exequias fuera de la Misa) y la entrega de los restos cremados. La introducción ofrece detalles específicos sobre la adaptación de los ritos funerarios. En total, el rito señala:

Los restos incinerados de un cadáver deben tratarse con el mismo respeto que se dispensa al cuerpo humano del que proceden. Esto incluye el uso de un recipiente digno para contener las cenizas, la forma en que se transportan y el cuidado y la atención que se presta a su colocación y transporte adecuados, así como a su disposición final. Los restos incinerados deben ser enterrados en una tumba o sepultados en un mausoleo o columbario. La práctica de esparcir los restos cremados en el mar, desde el aire, o en el suelo, o mantener los restos cremados en la casa de un familiar o amigo del difunto no son la disposición reverente que la Iglesia requiere. (n. 417)



Para algunas familias, la elección de la cremación se basa en dificultades financieras, por lo que esta elección a menudo significa también que no hay un plan para la inhumación o el entierro de los restos cremados. Como una forma de proporcionar apoyo pastoral y una solución aceptable y respetuosa al problema de los restos cremados no inhumados, una diócesis ofreció en el Día de Todos los Santos de 2011 una oportunidad para que cualquier familia que lo deseara pudiera inhumar los restos cremados. La diócesis ofreció una misa y un servicio de entierro en uno de sus cementerios católicos y proporcionó, de forma gratuita, una bóveda común en un mausoleo para el entierro de los restos incinerados. Los nombres de los difuntos allí enterrados se conservaban en los archivos, aunque en este caso no se inscribían individualmente en la bóveda.

A medida que se opta con más frecuencia por la cremación, habrá muchos que desconozcan la doctrina de la Iglesia sobre esta práctica. Es importante que los obispos y los párrocos no sólo catequicen a los fieles, sino que colaboren con los directores de las funerarias para proporcionar información útil y precisa a las familias que planean el funeral de sus seres queridos. Ofrecer oportunidades a los familiares para el entierro respetuoso de sus seres queridos, que no fueron inhumados después de los servicios funerarios y la cremación, daría un testimonio eficaz de la importancia del entierro cristiano y de nuestra creencia en la resurrección. En general, se anima a los pastores a mostrar sensibilidad pastoral, especialmente con aquellos para quienes la cremación es la única opción factible (véase el



Each year, on the second-to-last Sunday of October, Catholics around the world unite in celebration of World Mission Sunday—a day of prayer, reflection, and financial support for the Church’s missionary work in 1,124 mission territories. These are regions where the Church is still young, growing, and often facing poverty, conflict, or persecution.

World Mission Sunday is not just the occasion of another second collection. It is the one Sunday when the entire Catholic Church—every parish, in every country—comes together to pray for and support the missionary efforts of the Church through The Society for the Propagation of the Faith, one of the four Pontifical Mission Societies.




