Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

On 1 November 2025, Solemnity of All Saints, on the occasion of the Jubilee of the World of Education, at 10.30 am, on the parvis of Saint Peter's Basilica, the Holy Father Leo XIV will preside over the Eucharistic Celebration and the rite of proclamation as "Doctor of the Church" of Saint John Henry Newman.

Here is some information on Cardinal Newman.....

John Henry Newman (21 February 1801 – 11 August 1890) was an English Catholic theologian, academic, philosopher, historian, writer, and poet. He was previously an Anglican priest and after his conversion became a cardinal. He was an important figure in the religious history of England in the 19th century and was known nationally by the mid-1830s. He was canonized in 2019 by Pope Francis, and in 2025, it was announced that Pope Leo XIV approved the decision to name Newman a Doctor of the Church and would soon confer the title by a formal decree. He was a member of the Oratory of St. Philip Neri and founded the first house of that congregation in England.

Originally an evangelical academic at the University of Oxford and priest in the Church of England, Newman was drawn to the high church tradition of Anglicanism. He became one of the more notable leaders of the Oxford Movement, an influential grouping of Anglicans who wished to restore to the Church of England many Catholic beliefs and liturgical rituals from before the English Reformation. In this, the movement had some success. After publishing his Tract 90 in 1841, Newman later wrote: "I was on my death-bed, as regards my membership with the Anglican Church."

In 1845, Newman resigned his teaching post at Oxford University, and, joined by some but not all of his followers, officially left the Church of England and was received into the Catholic Church. He was quickly ordained as a priest and continued as an influential religious leader, based in Birmingham. In 1879, he was created a cardinal by Pope Leo XIII in recognition of his services to the cause of the Catholic Church in England. He was instrumental in the founding of the Catholic University of Ireland in 1854, which later became University College Dublin.

Newman was also a literary figure: his major writings include the Tracts for the Times (1833–1841), his autobiography *Apologia Pro Vita Sua* (1864), the *Grammar of Assent* (1870), and the poem *The Dream of Gerontius* (1865), which was set to music in 1900 by Edward Elgar. He wrote the popular hymns "Lead, Kindly Light", "Firmly I believe, and truly", and "Praise to the Holiest in the Height" (the latter two taken from *Gerontius*).

Newman's beatification was proclaimed by Pope Benedict XVI on 19 September 2010 during his visit to the United Kingdom. His canonization was officially approved by Pope Francis on 12 February 2019, and took place on 13 October 2019. He was proclaimed a Doctor of the Church by Pope Leo XIV, on July 31, 2025.

Queridos feligreses,

El 1 de noviembre de 2025, Solemnidad de Todos los Santos, con ocasión del Jubileo del Mundo de la Educación, a las 10.30 am, en el parvis de la Basílica de San Pedro, el Santo Padre León XIV presidirá la Celebración Eucarística y el rito de proclamación como "Doctor de la Iglesia" de San John Henry Newman.

He aquí algunos datos sobre el cardenal Newman.....

John Henry Newman (21 de febrero de 1801 - 11 de agosto de 1890) fue un teólogo, académico, filósofo, historiador, escritor y poeta católico inglés. Anteriormente fue sacerdote anglicano y tras su conversión se convirtió en cardenal. Fue una figura importante en la historia religiosa de Inglaterra en el siglo XIX y era conocido a nivel nacional a mediados de la década de 1830. Fue canonizado en 2019 por el Papa Francisco, y en 2025 se anunció que el Papa León XIV aprobó la decisión de nombrar a Newman Doctor de la Iglesia y que pronto conferiría el título mediante un decreto formal. Fue miembro del Oratorio de San Felipe Neri y fundó la primera casa de esa congregación en Inglaterra.

Originalmente académico evangélico en la Universidad de Oxford y sacerdote en la Iglesia de Inglaterra, Newman se sintió atraído por la alta tradición eclesiástica del anglicanismo. Se convirtió en uno de los líderes más notables del Movimiento de Oxford, una influyente agrupación de anglicanos que deseaban restaurar en la Iglesia de Inglaterra muchas creencias católicas y rituales litúrgicos anteriores a la Reforma inglesa. En esto, el movimiento tuvo cierto éxito. Tras publicar su Tract 90 en 1841, Newman escribió más tarde: "Estaba en mi lecho de muerte, en lo que respecta a mi pertenencia a la Iglesia anglicana".

En 1845, Newman renunció a su puesto de profesor en la Universidad de Oxford y, unido a algunos de sus seguidores, aunque no a todos, abandonó oficialmente la Iglesia de Inglaterra y fue recibido en la Iglesia católica. Rápidamente fue ordenado sacerdote y continuó como influyente líder religioso, con sede en Birmingham. En 1879, fue creado cardenal por el Papa León XIII en reconocimiento a sus servicios a la causa de la Iglesia católica en Inglaterra. Contribuyó decisivamente a la fundación de la Universidad Católica de Irlanda en 1854, que más tarde se convertiría en el University College de Dublín.

Newman fue también una figura literaria: entre sus principales escritos figuran los Tracts for the Times (1833-1841), su autobiografía *Apologia Pro Vita Sua* (1864), la *Grammar of Assent* (1870) y el poema *The Dream of Gerontius* (1865), al que Edward Elgar puso música en 1900. Escribió los himnos populares "Lead, Kindly Light", "Firmly I believe, and truly" y "Praise to the Holiest in the Height" (los dos últimos tomados de *Gerontius*).


La beatificación de Newman fue proclamada por el Papa Benedicto XVI el 19 de septiembre de 2010 durante su visita al Reino Unido. Su canonización fue aprobada oficialmente por el Papa Francisco el 12 de febrero de 2019, y tuvo lugar el 13 de octubre de 2019. Fue proclamado Doctor de la Iglesia por el Papa León XIV, el 31 de julio de 2025.

We are currently seeking candidates for the position of Director of Religious Education for St. Joseph, Lebanon. November opens with the Feast of All Saints and is followed by the Feast of All Souls. In the Hispanic culture, these two days are called the Day of the Dead, another beautiful celebration of death and life. During these early November celebrations, those of us still living (the Church militant) unite our hearts with, and in a special way remember, the faithful departed, whether they be in heaven (Church triumphant) or in purgatory (Church suffering).

All Saints Day is a solemn holy day of the Catholic Church celebrated annually on November 1. It is a day dedicated to all who have entered heaven, including the saints recognized by the Church and those not. Saturday, November 1, is the Solemnity of All Saints, because it is a Saturday, this year the obligation to attend Mass on this date is abrogated (not a holy day of obligation).

El Día de Todos los Santos es una fiesta solemne de la Iglesia Católica que se celebra anualmente el 1 de noviembre. DÍA DE LOS DIFUNTOS

On November 2nd, the day following All Saints' Day, all the deceased are remembered especially those who have recently died. All Souls' Day is a time for prayer for the departed souls who have not yet found eternal peace with God.

The tradition of the Day of the Dead is rooted in Indigenous and Spanish Catholic ritual customs. Dia de los Angelitos (Day of the little angels) starts the holiday at midnight on Nov 1st, where the spirits of all deceased children are believed to be reunited with their families for 24 hours. At midnight of the following day (November 2nd), the celebrations shift to honor the lives of the departed adults. The night is filled with laughter and fun memories, much like the night before. The next day is the grand finale and public celebration of Dia de Muertos. In more recent times, people come together in their cities, dressed up with Calavera painted faces (Skeletons) and have parades in the streets. Cemetery visits are also common on the last day as families will go to decorate the grave sites.

La tradición del Día de los Muertos tiene sus raíces en costumbres rituales indígenas y católicas españolas. El Día de los Angelitos comienza a medianoche del 1 de noviembre, cuando se cree que los espíritus de todos los niños difuntos se reúnen con sus familias durante 24 horas. A medianoche del día siguiente (2 de noviembre), las celebraciones pasan a honrar la vida de los adultos fallecidos. La noche se llena de risas y recuerdos divertidos, como la noche anterior. Al día siguiente es el gran final y la celebración pública del Día de Muertos. En épocas más recientes, la gente se reúne en sus ciudades, se disfrazan con caras pintadas de Calavera (esqueletos) y celebran desfiles por las calles. Las visitas a los cementerios también son habituales el último día, ya que las familias van a decorar las tumbas.






