

Dear Parishioners,

The Catholic Ministry Appeal is nearing its conclusion. So far, St. Mary's parishioners have contributed \$40,899 toward the goal of \$53,000, and St. Joseph's parishioners have contributed \$78,666 toward the \$87,000 goal. This means we still need to raise an additional \$12,101 at St. Mary's and \$8,334 at St. Joseph's before December 31 to meet our goals.




