

Dear St. Mary's Parish Family,  
The Conference thanks the parish for its support, not just  
financially and for your generous food donations; but for the  
prayers you offer supporting the Mission and those neighbors  
coming for assistance. Total receipts for the reporting year  
were \$109,463. Of this amount, parishioners provided  
\$56,358, fundraising events provided \$11,605, and we were  
given two grants – one from the Care Group for \$35,000 and  
one from the Diocese for \$6,500. Aid to your neighbors in the  
Clinton County community totaled \$81,111 for housing,  
utilities and other needs. Of this figure, housing assistance  
was \$29,891, Utilities \$30,889, and many other forms of  
assistance – emergency housing, car repairs, rehab fees,  
medications – even laundry. \$16,997 in food was distributed  
from St. Mary's Food Pantry. We were able to send \$1250 to  
National SVdP to help with disaster relief and grants to assist  
other Conferences with needs greater than their funding. Your  
SVdP Conference assisted 3937 people in crisis. The Food  
Pantry distributed 739 bags of groceries. Members provided  
2298 volunteer hours, and drove approximately 5976 miles to  
provide these services. Again, thank you for your generous, on-  
going support and prayers. Please join us in our Mission. We  
meet every 2nd and 4th Wednesdays at 8:30 am for Prayer  
and Formation in the Vincentian Rule.
