

# Pastor's Note...

Dear Parishioners,

I want to give an update on the staff in Frankfort and Lebanon.

We have hired Grace Barton to be a DRE in Lebanon. She starts on Monday. Norma is her supervisor.

We have also hired Jim Norris to help maintain the parish one day a week in Frankfort. He is Sheila's husband.

I believe that both of these persons will be a great asset to the Pastorate.

When receiving communion on the tongue, the etiquette involves approaching reverently, tilting your head back slightly, opening your mouth wide, and extending your tongue flat and still to create a clear "landing pad" for the priest to place the Host, then closing your mouth and consuming the Host immediately without biting, all while remaining still until the minister's hand is away, ensuring no particles are lost.

Steps for Receiving Communion on the Tongue:

1. Approach Reverently: Walk to the minister with a humble and prayerful heart, ensuring you are in a state of grace.
2. Respond "Amen": Say "Amen" clearly after the minister says, "The Body of Christ."
3. Position Your Head: Tilt your head back slightly, but not too far.
4. Open Mouth & Extend Tongue: Open your mouth wide and stick your tongue out, keeping it flat and still, extending it out for the priest to place the Host without touching your lips or fingers.
5. Remain Still: Do not move your head, tongue, or body while the Host is being placed.
6. Consume Immediately: Once the Host is on your tongue, gently bring your tongue back and close your mouth, consuming the Host right away.
7. Return to Pew: Walk back to your seat reverently to pray.

Key Things to Avoid:

- Biting: Do not use your teeth to take the Host.
- Licking: Avoid licking the minister's fingers.
- Movement: Moving makes it difficult for the minister to place the Host accurately.

This practice emphasizes humility and reverence, ensuring the precious Eucharist is received directly and securely, minimizing the risk of particles falling.

Queridos feligreses:

Quiero informarles sobre las novedades relacionadas con el personal de Frankfort y Lebanon.

Al recibir la comunión en la lengua, el protocolo consiste en acercarse con reverencia, inclinar ligeramente la cabeza hacia atrás, abrir bien la boca y extender la lengua de forma plana y quieta para crear una «plataforma de aterrizaje» clara para que el sacerdote coloque la hostia, luego cerrar la boca y consumir la hostia inmediatamente sin morder, todo ello permaneciendo quieto hasta que la mano del ministro se aleje, asegurándose de que no se pierda ninguna partícula.

Pasos para recibir la comunión en la lengua:

1. Acérquese con reverencia: acérquese al ministro con un corazón humilde y devoto, asegurándose de estar en estado de gracia.
2. Responda «Amén»: diga «Amén» claramente después de que el ministro diga «El Cuerpo de Cristo».
3. Posición de la cabeza: Incline ligeramente la cabeza hacia atrás, pero no demasiado.
4. Abre la boca y saca la lengua: Abre bien la boca y saca la lengua, manteniéndola plana y quieta, extendiéndola para que el sacerdote coloque la Hostia sin tocar tus labios ni tus dedos.
5. Permanezca quieto: No mueva la cabeza, la lengua ni el cuerpo mientras se coloca la Hostia.
6. Consuma inmediatamente: Una vez que la Hostia esté en su lengua, retire suavemente la lengua y cierre la boca, consumiendo la Hostia inmediatamente.
7. Vuelve al banco: Camina de vuelta a tu asiento con reverencia para rezar.

Cosas clave que hay que evitar:

- Morder: No utilices los dientes para tomar la Hostia.
- Lamer: Evite lamer los dedos del ministro.
- Movimiento: El movimiento dificulta que el ministro coloque la Hostia correctamente.

Esta práctica enfatiza la humildad y la reverencia, asegurando que la preciosa Eucaristía se reciba de manera directa y segura, minimizando el riesgo de que caigan partículas.






