

## Pastor's Note...

When receiving communion in the hand, create a "throne" with your hands (lower hand supports upper hand), say "Amen," take the host with your lower hand, and consume it immediately, stepping aside if needed, ensuring no crumbs are left behind. Always use two hands (unless physically impossible), and if you are holding something or have difficulty, receive on the tongue instead to show proper reverence for the Real Presence.

### Before Receiving

- Bow your head: As you approach the minister, bow your head slightly as a sign of reverence.
- Prepare your hands: Extend your hands to form a flat "throne" for the Host.
- Place your left hand flat, and your right hand (your dominant hand) flat underneath it, creating a base.
- If you are left-handed, you might want to place your left hand underneath.
- Say "Amen": Respond with a clear "Amen" to the minister's "The Body of Christ".

### Receiving the Host

- Receive gently: Allow the minister to place the Host in your hand.
- Consume immediately: Bring the Host to your mouth with your lower hand and consume it right away. Do not walk away holding the Host.
- Check for crumbs: Look at your lower hand for any small particles (crumbs) and consume them immediately, even wetting your finger if necessary.

### Important Considerations

- Two hands are key: Using only one hand is discouraged due to the risk of dropping the Host; use your tongue if both hands aren't available (e.g., holding a child).
- Reverence: The entire process should be done with reverence, remembering you are receiving Christ.
- Alternative: Receiving on the tongue is always an acceptable and equally reverent option, especially if you have difficulty with the hand method.

Al recibir la comunión en la mano, forme un «trono» con las manos (la mano inferior sostiene la superior), diga «Amén», tome la hostia con la mano inferior y consúmlala inmediatamente, apartándose si es necesario, asegurándose de que no queden migas. Utilice siempre las dos manos (a menos que sea físicamente imposible) y, si lleva algo en las manos o tiene dificultades, reciba la comunión en la lengua para mostrar la debida reverencia a la Presencia Real.

### Antes de recibirla

- Incline la cabeza: al acercarse al ministro, incline ligeramente la cabeza en señal de reverencia.
- Prepare las manos: extienda las manos para formar un «trono» plano para la Hostia.
- Coloque la mano izquierda plana y la derecha (su mano dominante) plana debajo de ella, creando una base.
- Si es zurdo, puede colocar la mano izquierda debajo.
- Diga «Amén»: Responda con un «Amén» claro al «Cuerpo de Cristo» del ministro.

### Recibir la Hostia

- Recibirla con delicadeza: Deje que el ministro le coloque la Hostia en la mano.
- Consumirla inmediatamente: Lleve la Hostia a la boca con la mano inferior y consúmlala inmediatamente. No se aleje con la Hostia en la mano.
- Comprobar si hay migas: Mire si hay pequeñas partículas (migas) en la mano inferior y consúmlalas inmediatamente, mojándose el dedo si es necesario.

### Consideraciones importantes

- Es fundamental utilizar las dos manos: no se recomienda utilizar solo una mano debido al riesgo de que se caiga la hostia; utilice la lengua si no puede utilizar las dos manos (por ejemplo, si sostiene a un niño).
- Reverencia: Todo el proceso debe realizarse con reverencia, recordando que está recibiendo a Cristo.
- Alternativa: Recibir la Hostia en la lengua es siempre una opción aceptable e igualmente reverente, especialmente si tiene dificultades con el método de la mano.






