A member of the Finance Committee asked me to put something in the bulletin about Charitable Giving from Retirement Funds. I found this article helpful. It is from plannedgiving.com I hope you find it helpful.



10 Reasons to Donate from Your Retirement Plan

Thinking about making a planned gift to your favorite nonprofit? You might want to consider making a gift from your retirement plan, such as an IRA. There are a number of benefits to donating retirement assets to a registered charity. You can easily make this gift through your will:

You Can Avoid Double Taxation for Your Heirs.

Did you know your retirement plan is potentially subject to double taxation if passed on to your heirs? This could cost them 50% or more in taxes! Instead of naming your heirs as beneficiaries of your retirement plan, name your favorite charity. Because it's a qualified 501(c)(3) nonprofit, there's no income or estate or inheritance tax due on your retirement plan assets passing to them. Then pass other assets that are not as highly taxed — things like stocks, bonds, and real estate — to your heirs.

You Can Offset Estate Taxes.

As long as the value of the donated assets is included in your gross estate, you are entitled to a charitable tax deduction when you donate your IRA.

You Can Take Advantage of the IRA Charitable Rollover.

If you're 70½ or older, you can make current gifts totaling up to \$105,000 per year from your IRA to a nonprofit using the IRA Charitable Rollover provision and not pay income tax on those withdrawals. This is also known as a Qualified Charitable Deduction (QCD).

You Can Make Gifts That Count As Your RMD.

If you're 73 or older, you must take a required minimum distribution (RMD) from your retirement plan each year. By donating these (up to \$105,000 a year), your RMD counts as a qualified charitable distribution (QCD), eliminating income taxes on the distribution.

It's As Simple as Signing a Form.

When you're ready to donate retirement assets, you typically need to fill out a designated beneficiary form and make a charity the beneficiary. Your employer or retirement plan administrator will supply this form.

It's a Flexible Giving Option.

You don't have to give all of your retirement account to charity, or even to a single charity — you can divide assets between charities or, if you choose, other heirs (see Point # 1, above, first). Your assets can be distributed according to any percentages you want.

You Can Make a Big Difference with No Impact on Your Daily Cash Flow.

By donating unneeded retirement assets, you can make a larger gift than you may have thought possible.

You'll Invest in Your Legacy.

Giving to your favorite charity is a way to create and sustain your own legacy by making a difference far into the future and helping generations to come.

Numerous studies have shown charitable contributions create a positive, "feel good" response in the brain. Couple that with the tax savings you'll realize, and you'll find a gift from your retirement plan will contribute to your own long-term happiness.

Diez razones para donar desde su plan de jubilación

¿Está pensando en hacer una donación planificada a su organización sin ánimo de lucro favorita? Quizás le interese considerar la posibilidad de hacer una donación desde su plan de jubilación, como una cuenta IRA. Donar activos de jubilación a una organización benéfica registrada tiene varias ventajas. Puede hacer esta donación fácilmente a través de su testamento:

Puede evitar la doble imposición para sus herederos.

¿Sabía que su plan de jubilación puede estar sujeto a doble imposición si se transfiere a sus herederos? ¡Esto podría suponerles un coste fiscal del 50 % o más! En lugar de nombrar a sus herederos como beneficiarios de su plan de jubilación, nombre a su organización benéfica favorita. Al tratarse de una organización sin ánimo de lucro 501(c)(3) cualificada, no hay que pagar impuestos sobre la renta, el patrimonio o la herencia por los activos de su plan de jubilación que se les transfieran. A continuación, transfiera a sus herederos otros activos que no estén tan gravados, como acciones, bonos y bienes inmuebles.

Puede compensar los impuestos sobre el patrimonio.

Siempre que el valor de los activos donados se incluya en su patrimonio bruto, tendrá derecho a una deducción fiscal por donación benéfica cuando done su IRA.

Puede aprovechar la transferencia benéfica de IRA.

Si tiene 70 años y medio o más, puede hacer donaciones actuales por un total de hasta 105 000 dólares al año desde su IRA a una organización sin ánimo de lucro utilizando la disposición de transferencia caritativa de la IRA y no pagar impuestos sobre la renta por esas retiradas. Esto también se conoce como deducción caritativa cualificada (QCD).

Puede hacer donaciones que cuenten como su RMD.

Si tiene 73 años o más, debe realizar una distribución mínima obligatoria (RMD) de su plan de jubilación cada año. Al donar estas cantidades (hasta 105 000 dólares al año), su RMD cuenta como una distribución caritativa cualificada (QCD), lo que elimina los impuestos sobre la renta de la distribución.

Es tan sencillo como firmar un formulario.

Cuando esté listo para donar activos de jubilación, normalmente tendrá que rellenar un formulario de beneficiario designado y nombrar a una organización benéfica como

beneficiaria. Su empleador o el administrador de su plan de jubilación le proporcionarán este formulario.

Es una opción de donación flexible.

No tiene que donar toda su cuenta de jubilación a una organización benéfica, ni siquiera a una sola organización benéfica: puede dividir los activos entre varias organizaciones benéficas o, si lo prefiere, entre otros herederos (véase el punto n.º 1, más arriba). Sus activos se pueden distribuir según los porcentajes que usted desee.

Puede marcar una gran diferencia sin que ello afecte a su flujo de caja diario.

Al donar activos de jubilación que no necesita, puede hacer una donación mayor de lo que hubiera imaginado.

Invertirá en su legado.

Donar a su organización benéfica favorita es una forma de crear y mantener su propio legado, marcando la diferencia en el futuro y ayudando a las generaciones venideras.

Se sentirá más feliz.

Numerosos estudios han demostrado que las contribuciones benéficas crean una respuesta positiva y de «bienestar» en el cerebro. Si a eso le sumamos el ahorro fiscal que obtendrá, descubrirá que una donación de su plan de jubilación contribuirá a su propia felicidad a largo plazo.

Ayudará a promover una causa que le importa.
