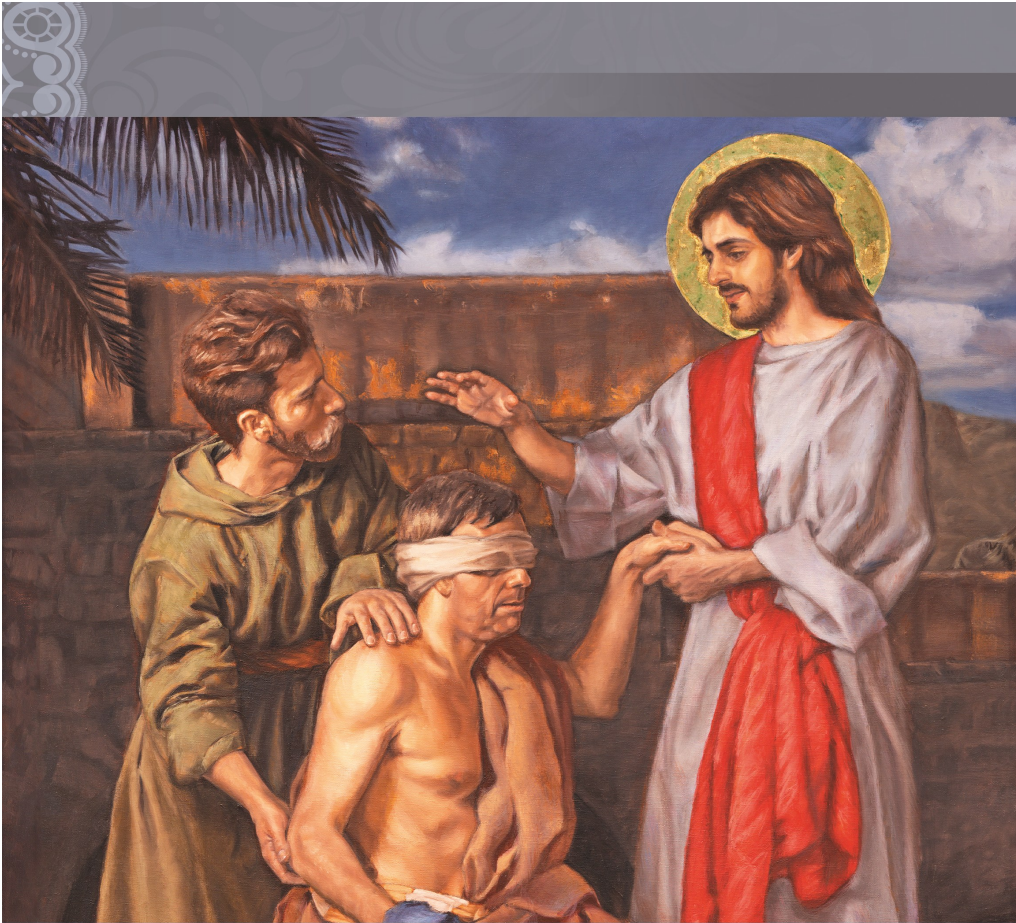

Dear Parishioners,

I am concerned about our pledges to the Catholic Ministry Appeal. We need many more parishioners to make a pledge.

Helping with the Bishop's office is very important. The Bishop has office expenses, he runs a marriage tribunal, he pays for the tuition of Seminarians. In our two parishes Andy Guljas has provided great leadership in helping St. Mary's complete the parking lot project and St. Joseph's work on the Master Plan.
