St. Joseph's Workshop—Benefactors Wanted!

St. Joseph's workshop is located in the room off of the cafeteria. This room used to be used by our daycare when it was still open. The goal of Joseph's workshop is not just to be able to learn some skills with woodworking and building, it is a place where the students will be able to discover many other lessons in geology and archeology. There will also be places where the students can observe animals. Currently, we have a couple of parakeets in a bird aviary, a corn snake, and a tank of fish. These areas will grow over time.

Other things that our students will do in the workshop will be "The Dig Box" and the study of different rocks and fossils. The Dig Box will be a place where our students will be able to dig for fossils, be taught how to properly clean them, identify what part of the body the bone has come from, and catalog it into their findings.

This place will have so many opportunities for all of our students to continue to grow in their knowledge of many different areas. Many of the students have already been in the workshop and are always very excited to return!
