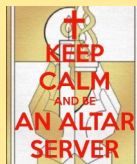

Applicants must be 18 years of age or older and be able to pass a background check. This job is perfect for college students or retired individuals who love working with kids.

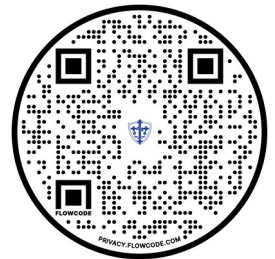
