

Each day, the progress continues inside Our Lady of Victory Chapel! Enjoy a look at some of the latest projects, installations and beautiful art added to our chapel this summer.


STATIONS OF THE CROSS

549 ORGAN PIPES

Fun Fact: There are 549 pipes in our organ! Each pipe was carefully wrapped to be transported here - then unwrapped and placed in each spot to create our masterpiece organ.




These remarkable pieces of art have been placed high above the 26-foot tall windows on the sides of the chapel.
