

Fourteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time

(Readings: Zechariah 9:9-10 — Romans 8:9, 11-13 — Matthew 11:25-30)

Little Ones — Mélanie Calvat and Maximin Giraud would certainly fit the description of “little ones” as stated by Jesus, i.e. the opposite of “the wise and the learned;” even though there was a school in their home town of Corps, they were uneducated. Fr. Joseph Ross, M.S., believes that if Our Lady had appeared to a priest, her story would never have been told, because the priest himself would not have believed what he had seen and heard. One might doubt the accuracy of that statement, but the fact remains that “wisdom and learning” can get in the way. It appears that “meekness, which appears in the first reading and in the Gospel, is a prerequisite. The word “meek” conjures up a certain image. Mélanie, for example, was by all reports small for her age—just under 15—and quite withdrawn. Maximin, on the other hand, who had turned 11 a few weeks before the Apparition, was lively and forward to the point of rudeness. Neither one was meek in the conventional sense. But they were deprived and dependent, and in that sense obligatorily or “socially” meek,” of no particular importance to the world in which they lived. There is no record that either of the children ever boasted, in later life, of having seen the Blessed Virgin. In September 1861 Maximin, now 26, was at La Salette and once again told the story of what he had seen and heard there as a boy. At the end, when he described the Beautiful Lady’s disappearance, he commented: “She left me here, with all my faults.” Maximin and Mélanie lived good but unsettled lives. No one has ever accused them of any wrongdoing in their personal behavior, but neither did they rise to any level of greatness, though Mélanie did have a certain following. In a real sense they remained “little ones” to their death, he in 1875 at the age of 39, she in 1904 at 63. They are models to us. We too, with all our faults, can be faithful, in genuine meekness, to the task that God has assigned us. Little ones we may be, but empowered by God just the same.

Reflexión....

Los pequeños

(Decimocuarto domingo del tiempo ordinario: **Zacarías 9:9-10; Romanos 8:9-13; Mateo 11:25-30**)

Jesús agradece a su Padre por haber revelado “estas cosas” a “los sencillos” y no a “los sabios e inteligentes”. El no dice qué son esas cosas específicas que tiene en mente. El pensar es más general: el Padre ha mostrado su preferencia por los humildes y los pequeños. El Magníficat de María refleja la misma realidad.

No hay que extrañarse entonces de que en la mayoría de las Apariciones, Nuestra Señora haya elegido a “los pequeños” como sus testigos. La Salette no es una excepción. Es difícil imaginar que pudieran haber personas más humildes que Maximino Giraud y Melania Calvat. Aun después de haber recibido una educación, ellos no se pusieron por encima de la mayoría de sus pares que recibieron una educación similar.

Se rumoreaba lo contrario. Una carta fechada en 19 de febrero de 1845 – cinco meses después de la Aparición – y enviada al párroco de Corps, incluía un relato de la Aparición que entre otros errores incluía la siguiente declaración acerca de los niños: “De miedosos que eran, se convertían de repente en osados; de simples campesinos que eran se hicieron intelectuales y elocuentes”

Es cierto que asombraban a la gente con las repuestas que daban a preguntas tramposas, y su resistencia a las presiones que se les ponían para que negaran lo que habían visto y oído. Pero lo hicieron con gran simplicidad. Seguían siendo “los pequeños”

Jesús se describe a sí mismo como “el manso” y encontramos el mismo adjetivo usado para el rey que estaba por venir, en la primera lectura. Jesús también nos dice que aprendamos de él. En otro lugar nos dice que seamos como niños pequeños.

Esta mansedumbre ciertamente se adapta a aquellos a quienes San Pablo describe como “en el Espíritu”. Aquellos en quienes “el Espíritu de Dios habita” esos no pueden ser arrogantes, ni creerse superiores a los demás.

Se dice que a Maximino siendo adulto se le pidió relatar la historia de la Bella Señora una vez más. Él lo hizo, y concluyó con estas palabras: “Y luego ella desapareció, y me dejó aquí con mis defectos”

Que espléndido ejemplo de mansedumbre de la que Jesús habla: Reconociendo la gracia de Dios y nuestra indignidad. Todos podemos ser “los pequeños” en este sentido.


