Thirty-First Sunday of Ordinary Time

Great Commandments

(31st Ordinary Sunday: Deuteronomy 6:2-6; Hebrews 7:23-28; Mark 12:28-34)

When we see images of the tablets of the Ten Commandments, they often show on one tablet our obligations to God and, on the other, our duties towards our neighbor. The question of the scribe in today's Gospel, and Jesus' answer did not refer to these. However, there can be no controversy as to which of the ten came first. Rather, the debate concerned which of the 600-plus commandments and statutes of the Law was the most important. Jesus' response is so important that the Church gives us its source in the first reading, and the scribe repeats what Jesus says. We see here, also, an encouraging example of what it means to be in harmony with Christ's teachings, when Jesus tells him: "You are not far from the kingdom of God." At La Salette, the Blessed Virgin also mirrored the same message, though from a different perspective. She showed that, by failing to give the Lord the Day he had reserved to himself, and by abusing his Name, her people did not love God. In her message, the Beautiful Lady touched explicitly on the commandments of the "first tablet." It would be absurd, however, to think that our duties to our neighbor were of no importance to her. In her discourse, the "Field of Coin" episode recognizes at least the responsibility of parents toward their children. Jesus was not asked about the "second" commandment. He added it: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself" (Leviticus 19:18). First and second are so integrated and intertwined in the Christian vision that each leads to the other, each stems from the other. It follows that when we accept Mary's message and respond to her tears and words, we seek reconciliation with both God and neighbor. In this way, on our journey to becoming saints, we submit to the call and charism of La Salette. Our hearts have a deep desire to cry out with the Psalmist, "I love you, Lord, my strength!" But we have to mean it, and live it. Jesus is "able to save those who approach God through him" (second reading). When we love him and our neighbor, we hope to hear him say, "You are not far from the kingdom of God."

REFLEXION

Grandes Mandamientos

(31ero Domingo Ordinario: Deuteronomio 6:2-6; Hebreos 7:23-28; Marcos 12:28-34) Cuando vemos imágenes de las tablas de los Diez Mandamientos, con frecuencia vemos que en una están nuestras obligaciones con relación a Dios y en la otra, nuestros deberes para con nuestro prójimo.

La pregunta del escriba en el Evangelio de hoy, y la respuesta de Jesús no se refieren a aquellos. Sin embargo, no hay controversia acerca de cuál de los diez mandamientos es el primero. Más bien, el debate aquí surge en torno a cuál de los 600 mandamientos y estatutos de Ley era el más importante. La Respuesta de Jesús es tan importante que la Iglesia nos da su fuente en la primera lectura, y el escriba repite lo que Jesús dice. Aquí vemos, también, un ejemplo animador de lo que significa estar en armonía con las enseñanzas de Cristo, cuando Jesús le dice: “Tú no estás lejos del Reino de Dios”. En La Salette, en las palabras de la Santísima Virgen también se vio reflejado el mismo mensaje, aunque desde una perspectiva diferente. Ella demostró que, al no concederle al Señor el día que Él se eligió, y al usar en vano su Nombre, su pueblo no amaba a Dios. En su mensaje, la Bella Señora se refirió de manera explícita a los mandamientos de la “primera tabla”. Sería absurdo, sin embargo, pensar que nuestros deberes con nuestro prójimo no fueran importantes para ella. En su discurso, en el episodio de la “Tierra de Coin” ella deja entrever al menos la responsabilidad de los padres con relación a los hijos. A Jesús no le preguntaron acerca del “segundo” mandamiento. Él lo añadió: “Amarás a tu prójimo como a ti mismo” (Levítico 19:18). El primero y el segundo están tan integrados y entrelazados en la visión de la vida cristiana que el uno lleva al otro, cada uno surge del otro. Se sigue que cuando aceptamos el mensaje de María y respondemos a sus lágrimas y a sus palabras, buscamos la reconciliación con Dios y con el prójimo al mismo tiempo. De esta manera, durante nuestro camino a la santidad, nos sometemos a la vocación y al carisma de La Salette. Nuestros corazones desean profundamente exclamar como el Salmista, “Yo te amo, ¡Señor, mi fuerza!” pero debe ser en serio. Jesús “puede salvar en forma definitiva a los que se acercan a Dios por su intermedio” (segunda lectura). Cuando amamos a Jesús y a nuestro prójimo, esperamos escucharle decir, “Tú no estás lejos del Reino de Dios”. Traducción: Hno. Moisés Rueda, M.S.

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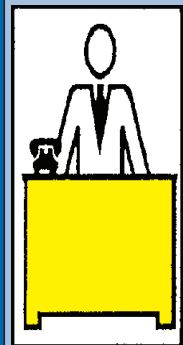
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
