



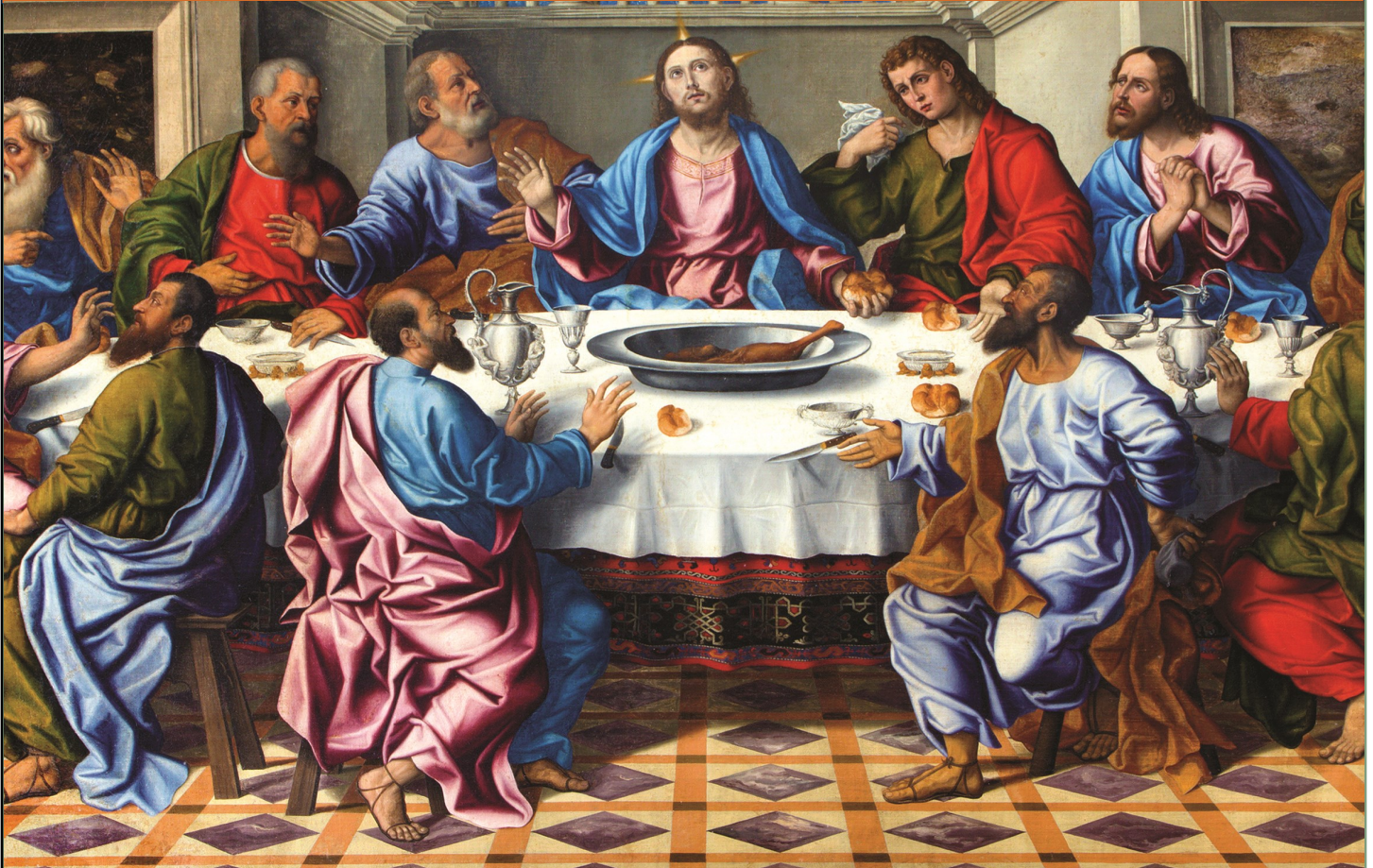

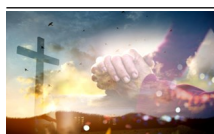

A WORD FROM OUR

Pastor

“Moments of Grace: The Significance of Sacred Events”

Dear Parish Family,

Throughout the pages of Scripture, we are invited into the story of salvation not just through teachings and parables, but through *events*—real, sacred moments in the life of Jesus Christ that reveal to us the heart of God. These moments are not mere history; they are living signs of God’s presence, meant to be pondered, prayed, and lived.

Pope Saint John Paul II, with his deep love for the Church and devotion to Mary, gave us the Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary to help us do just that. In these mysteries—the Baptism of the Lord, the Wedding at Cana, the Proclamation of the Kingdom, the Transfiguration, and the Institution of the Eucharist—we are drawn into the “mysteries of light” that illuminate the mission and identity of Jesus. Through them, we are reminded that God’s saving grace is revealed not only in His Passion and Resurrection, but also in the radiant moments of His earthly ministry, his miracles and his compassion and mercy.

As we continue through the Sundays of Easter, the Church calls us to reflect on the events that crown the life of Christ: His glorious Resurrection, His Ascension into heaven, and the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. These are not isolated events; they are deeply connected in the ongoing life of the Church. The Resurrection is our assurance that death is not the end. The Ascension reminds us that Christ reigns in glory and intercedes for us. Pentecost marks the birth of the Church, a Spirit-filled community called to continue the mission of Jesus. These events define who we are as Catholics: *pilgrims of hope, of mission, and of living communion with God.*

But what do these sacred moments mean for us, here and now, in our daily lives? They invite us to respond—to open our hearts to the power and grace that flows from them. The Resurrection gives us strength in trials, the Ascension gives us purpose, and Pentecost gives us courage. We are not alone. The Holy Spirit continues to move among us, inspiring us to love God with all our hearts and to serve our neighbors with compassion and humility. Here at Blessed Trinity, we are called to live as servant-disciples—rooted in prayer, strengthened by the sacraments, and committed to walking together in faith as the Body of Christ.

As we reflect on these truths, I am reminded of the countless parishioners who have gone before us—faithful women and men who built this community with their prayer, generosity, and witness. Their legacy lives on in every Mass we celebrate, every ministry we serve, and every soul we welcome. We walk in their footsteps, and we carry their torch forward—not only in memory, but in mission. May their example inspire us to live more fully the sacred events of our faith, not just in word but in deeds.

Estimada Familia Parroquial,

El Papa San Juan Pablo II, con su profundo amor por la Iglesia y su devoción a María, nos legó los Misterios Luminosos del Rosario para ayudarnos a lograr precisamente eso. En estos misterios —el Bautismo del Señor, las Bodas de Caná, la Proclamación del Reino, la Transfiguración y la Institución de la Eucaristía— somos atraídos a los “misterios de luz” que iluminan la misión y la identidad de Jesús. A través de ellos, recordamos que la gracia salvadora de Dios se revela no solo en su Pasión y Resurrección, sino también en los momentos radiantes de su ministerio terrenal, sus milagros, su compasión y misericordia.

Al continuar durante los próximos Domingos de Pascua, la Iglesia nos llama a reflexionar sobre los acontecimientos que coronan la vida de Cristo: su gloriosa Resurrección, su Ascensión al cielo y la efusión del Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés. Estos no son eventos aislados; están profundamente conectados con la vida continua de la Iglesia. La Resurrección nos asegura que la muerte no es el fin. La Ascensión nos recuerda que Cristo reina en gloria e intercede por nosotros. Pentecostés marca el nacimiento de la Iglesia, una comunidad llena del Espíritu llamada a continuar la misión de Jesús. Estos eventos definen quiénes somos como católicos: *peregrinos de esperanza, de misión y de comunión viva con Dios.*

Pero ¿qué significan estos momentos sagrados para nosotros, aquí y ahora, en nuestra vida diaria? Nos invitan a responder, a abrir nuestros corazones al poder y la gracia que fluyen de ellas. La Resurrección nos da fuerza en las pruebas, la Ascensión nos da propósito y Pentecostés nos da valentía. No estamos solos. El Espíritu Santo sigue obrando entre nosotros, inspirándonos a amar a Dios con todo nuestro corazón y a servir al prójimo con compasión y humildad. Aquí en Blessed Trinity, estamos llamados a vivir como discípulos-siervos, arraigados en la oración, fortalecidos por los sacramentos y comprometidos a caminar juntos en la fe como Cuerpo de Cristo.

Al reflexionar sobre estas verdades, recuerdo a los innumerables feligreses que nos han precedido: mujeres y hombres fieles que construyeron esta comunidad con su oración, generosidad y testimonio. Su legado perdura en cada misa que celebramos, en cada ministerio al que servimos y en cada alma que acogemos. Seguimos sus pasos y llevamos su antorcha, no solo en memoria, sino también en misión. Que su ejemplo nos inspire a vivir más plenamente los eventos sagrados de nuestra fe, no solo con palabras, sino con hechos.

Preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation: A Journey of Faith and Transformation - At Blessed Trinity Catholic Parish, we are deeply committed to forming our teens in the fullness of our Catholic faith. The **Sacrament of Confirmation** is a profound moment in this journey—a sacred encounter in which our young people are **sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit**, strengthened to be **courageous witnesses of Christ**, and called to live lives of deeper discipleship. The **Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC 1285)** teaches us that “**Baptism, the Eucharist, and the sacrament of Confirmation together constitute the ‘sacraments of Christian initiation’**, whose unity must be

safeguarded.” Confirmation is not an ending, but a powerful **beginning**—a commissioning to serve and evangelize as active members of the Church.

In our high school **Life Teen Ministry**, our teens gather on Sunday evenings during the school-year in a dynamic community of faith, learning, prayer, and fellowship. This ministry plays a vital role in helping our young people **encounter Christ personally**, grow in their knowledge of the faith, and develop a deeper love for the Church.

As part of our **updated parish policy**, students preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation are expected to:

- Participate fully in the **Life Teen Sunday evening program for one complete school year prior to beginning the Confirmation preparation process**.
- Attend **additional Sunday afternoon sessions** specifically designed for Confirmation candidates, as required by the **Diocese of Orlando**.

We understand this represents a change from past practice. However, we have already seen the fruits of this enhanced formation. Our parish teens who have walked this path testify to a **renewed sense of purpose**, a deeper connection to their **Catholic identity**, and an eagerness to serve Christ through the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Parents and **chosen Sponsors** are also essential to this journey. Through prayer, example, and encouragement, they accompany our young people and help nurture the graces received in this sacrament. Together, we witness a true transformation—our youth becoming **faith-filled servant-leaders**, guided by the Holy Spirit, ready to live out their Confirmation with zeal.

Let us continue to pray for our teens, their families, and all involved in this beautiful and vital process of preparation. May the Holy Spirit stir in their hearts a deep and lasting desire to follow Jesus and serve His Church with love.

STEPS OF ST. PAUL & MEDJUGORJE

13 DAY TRAVEL ITINERARY

DAY 01 / OCT 06 ATLANTA OR HOUSTON / ATHENS

Depart Atlanta or Houston to Athens.

Day 02 / OCT 07 ATHENS

Upon arrival in Athens, you will be met and transferred to St. Dennis Cathedral for Mass then proceed to the hotel for dinner and overnight. Hotels **Athens Moxy**.

Day 03 / OCT 08 ATHENS / CORINTH / MYCENEA / ATHENS

You will be met with the guide and driver at the port, and then you will drive to Corinth. You will have a photo stop at the Corinth Canal. Visit the Ancient Corinth, the Excavations, and the Bema Seat. Lunch on their own. On to Mycenae, a mighty kingdom of ancient Greece and a military stronghold. See the Beehive Tombs, the Treasury of Atreus. Visit the remains of the ancient city, including the Lioness gate, the tomb of Agamemnon and the Palace. Return to Athens for dinner and overnight. Hotels **Athens Moxy**.

DAY 04 / OCT 09 ATHENS

Breakfast at the hotel and Holy Mass at St. Dennis Cathedral. You will continue with tour of Athens to include the Acropolis, Mars Hill, one of Paul's most important gospel presentations at the time of his visit to Athens during his second missionary journey (ACTS 17:16-34), It was where he addressed the religious idolatry of the Greeks. Visit the Parthenon at Acropolis and then see, the Agora, the ruins of the Ancient market place where Socrates questioned the market – goes about the understanding of the meaning of life. Then we will have city tour. We will see the Temple of Zeus, the Athenian Trilogy, the Hadrian Gate. See the Changing of the Guard at Syntagma Square and Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the former Royal Palace. Stop at the Plaka District. Rest of the day at leisure. Dinner and overnight. Hotels **Athens Moxy**.



Meteora

DAY 05 / OCT 10 ATHENS / LAVRION / MYKONOS

Transfer to the port of Piraeus and board your cruise ship for a 4-day, 3-night cruise of the Aegean Sea. It is said that three days on the Aegean gives one a true sense of Greece's layered history and a great respect for the God-given majesty of the Aegean's breath-taking islands. Holy Mass will be celebrated on board. The first port call is Mykonos, an island of beautiful beaches, secluded coves, dazzling white-washed houses, narrow paved streets and windmills which cover the island. Mykonos is also known for its churches - 365 of them dot the beautiful island. Return to the ship for dinner and overnight at sea.

DAY 06 / OCT 11 PATMOS / KUSADASI (EPHESUS)

You will have an early morning arrival at the port of Kusadasi (Ephesus). Disembark the ship and board your coach for a visit to the ancient city of Ephesus for a guided walking tour through one of the most magnificent excavated cities in the world. **We will visit the house of the Virgin Mary where we will have mass.** See the Odeon (concert hall), the Fountain of Trajan, the steam-heated Baths of Sclastika, the Temple of Hadrian and the latrines, the Library of Celsus and the Great Theatre of Ephesus where Paul preached. Return to your coach via the Arcadian Way where Marc Anthony and Cleopatra once rode in procession as newlyweds. Return to the ship for a short sail to the island of Patmos for a visit to the Monastery of St. John where the original gospel manuscript is on display. Then visit the Grotto of the Apocalypse where you see the silver niches in the wall that mark the pillow and ledge used as a desk by the author of the Book of Revelations as well as the three-fold crack made by the voice of God. Return to the ship for dinner and your overnight sailing to Crete.



Thessaloniki

DAY 07 / OCT 12 CRETE / SANTORINI

You will have an early morning arrival at the port of Heraklion (Crete) for a tour of Knossos, once the capital city of the prehistoric Minoan civilization. You will have Holy Mass at St. John the Baptist church and then enjoy a tour of the excavations of the Palace of King Minos and the surrounding area. Return to the ship for a short sail to the island of Santorini. Depart the ship by tender to Athenios Harbor to board your motor coach for an uphill drive to the Village of Oia. Enjoy free time exploring the city of Oia before returning to the ship for your overnight sail to Piraeus.

DAY 08 / OCT 13 ATHENS / DUBROVNIK / MEDJUGORJE

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Dubrovnik. Upon arrival, assistance and transfer to your hotel. Dinner and overnight stay in Medjugorje.

DAYS 9&10 / OCT 14-15 MEDJUGORJE (2 DAYS)

During our stay in peaceful Medjugorje, we will meet and share your faith with thousands of pilgrims from all over the world. Each morning at 10 there will assemble at St. James Church for the English language mass. Your local guide will accompany you during the next couple of days as you follow the same path up the Apparition Hill where the young visionaries first encountered Our Lady. Contemplate the inspired artistry of the bronze plaques depicting each mystery of the rosary as we climb Podbrdo Hill. Touch and pray before the cross, commemorating the spot where Mary appeared to the visionaries. See from afar and then climb Krizevac Mountain, where in 1933 the villagers built a 30' high cross on the anniversary of Jesus' crucifixion. Today, wooden crosses and bronze images line the path up the hill, representing the Stations of the Cross. Your guide will arrange a meeting with one of the visionaries in their own homes or a public place. In the evening, you can join the villagers and pilgrims for the evening Croation Mass and the Blessing of the Sick. Spend time in prayer and meditation at the most peaceful place in the whole world where our Blessed Mother first appeared to the children. You will return for dinner and overnight in Medjugorje from October 14-16, then depart to Dubrovnik for dinner and overnight on October 16th.

DAY 11 / OCT 16 DUBROVNIK / EXCURSION TO MONTENEGRO

After breakfast, we depart for the Republic of Montenegro. Head towards the mouth of the beautiful Bay of Kotor, the longest and deepest fjord in the Southern Europe. Enjoy a boat ride to Our Lady of the Rocks, one of two islets off the coast of Perast. The Roman Catholic Church is the largest building on the islet, with a museum attached to it. Upon return to the coast, we will stop at

Perast, an old charming coastal town. Visit city of Kotor where we visit St. Ozana Church. Rest of the day is at leisure before returning to your hotel for dinner and overnight in Dubrovnik.

DAY 12 / OCT 17 DUBROVNIK / SARAJEVO

Enjoy a walking tour of the Old City, beginning at Saint Blaise's Church dedicated to the Patron Saint of Dubrovnik. This baroque-style Church, constructed by Venetian architect Marino Gropelli in 1715, was styled after the Venetian Church, St. Mauritius. You will know that you have reached this masterpiece by its large staircase leading to the ornamented main portal and the large dome that decorates the roof. Continue to view the Gothic and Renaissance styled Rector's Palace, home to the History of Department Museum of Dubrovnik. Next, you will stroll by iconic Bell Tower Clock and Orlando's Column. To the left of the column, see the Sponza Palace. In the sixteenth century, members of the Academia Dei Concordi met on the first-floor hall to discuss literature. As a result, the palace is the most important cultural institution of Dubrovnik. Lastly, visit the Dominican and Franciscan Monasteries. The Dominican Monastery, strategically located at the most sensitive point of Dubrovnik's defense barriers. While at the Franciscan Monastery, you will have the opportunity to visit the pharmacy. The founding of this pharmacy was collaborative, serving the public and the needs of monks. This afternoon, enjoy lunch on your own at one of the many, small family-owned restaurants along the narrow streets. On to Sarajevo for dinner and overnight.
