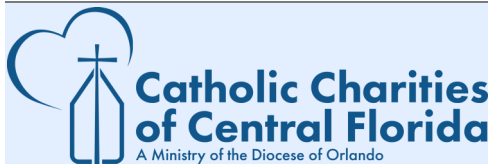

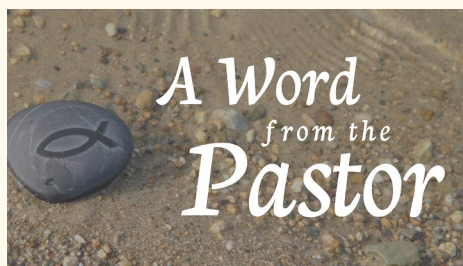

The Mission and the Mantle

Reflection for the 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time – July 6, 2025

This weekend's Gospel from St. Luke tells of the very first mission—an early moment of evangelization—entrusted to the newly “called and sent” disciples of Jesus. With striking clarity, Jesus gives them their marching orders: travel light, accept hospitality with humility, share the peace of God, and most importantly, proclaim the nearness of the

coming Kingdom. If they are received, they are to remain in gratitude and mutual blessing. If rejected, they are to move on without bitterness, knowing the mission is greater than any one moment and any one missionary.

What is deeply moving is the joyful return of these disciples. Their hearts overflow with more than success—it is a Spirit-filled joy that affirms Jesus' promises and reveals the lasting fruits of faithful service. Jesus assures them [*and us*] that “their names are written in heaven.” No other honor or reward is needed.

This mission of Christ continues today through the Church—and in a very personal way, through our own parish of **Blessed Trinity Catholic Community**. The grace of Jesus' call—a vocation to servant-ministry—is alive in the witness of those who have gone before us: the founders and families, the priests and religious, the forerunners and the faithful who planted seeds of faith, often quietly, generously and sacrificially. Their legacy of discipleship is woven into the very fabric of our parish life—through ministries of hospitality, faith formation, outreach to the poor, prayer, music, and the tireless efforts of many who served with no desire for recognition, only love for the Lord and His people.

Their charisms—humility, joy, perseverance, welcome, prayerfulness, and reconciliation 70 x 7—continue to echo in our hearts and, we trust, in heaven.

Now, it is our time.

The mission of Jesus—animated by the Holy Spirit—is not a story of the past, but a living call placed into our hands. Today, as disciples of the Risen Lord in this time and place, we are invited to **pick up the mantle** and go forth with courage, faith, and joy. Let us not be afraid to share the peace of Christ, to speak the truth of the Gospel, and to pray always: “**Lord, send more laborers into your harvest.**”

May Blessed Trinity Parish continue to be a place where vocations are nurtured, charisms flourish, and every baptized person finds their call to serve in love.

La Misión y el Manto - Reflexión para el 14° Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario – 6 de julio de 2025

El Evangelio de San Lucas para este fin de semana narra la primera misión — un momento inicial de evangelización— encomendada a los discípulos recién “*llamados y enviados*” de Jesús. Con una claridad contundente, Jesús les da las instrucciones: viajar ligeros, aceptar la hospitalidad con humildad, compartir la paz de Dios y, sobre todo, proclamar la cercanía del Reino venidero. Si son recibidos, deben permanecer en gratitud y bendición mutua. Si son rechazados, deben seguir adelante sin amargura, sabiendo que la misión es más grande que cualquier momento y cualquier misionero.



Lo que resulta profundamente conmovedor es el alegre regreso de estos discípulos. Sus corazones se desbordan de algo más que éxito: es una alegría llena del Espíritu que afirma las promesas de Jesús y revela los frutos duraderos del servicio fiel. Jesús les asegura [y nos asegura a nosotros] que “sus nombres están escritos en el cielo”. No necesitan ningún otro honor ni recompensa.

Esta misión de Cristo continúa hoy a través de la Iglesia y, de manera muy personal, a través de nuestra parroquia, la Comunidad Católica de **Blessed Trinity**. La gracia del llamado de Jesús —una vocación al servicio ministerial— está viva en el testimonio de quienes nos precedieron: los fundadores y sus familias, los sacerdotes y religiosos, los precursores y los fieles que sembraron la fe, a menudo de forma silenciosa, generosa y sacrificada. Su legado de discipulado está entrelazado en la esencia misma de nuestra vida parroquial, a través de los ministerios de hospitalidad, formación en la fe, ayuda a los pobres, oración, música y el esfuerzo incansable de muchos que sirvieron sin buscar reconocimiento, solo con amor al Señor y a Su pueblo.

Sus carismas — humildad, alegría, perseverancia, bienvenida, oración y reconciliación 70 x 7 — siguen resonando en nuestros corazones y, confiamos, en el cielo.

Ahora es nuestro momento.

La misión de Jesús, animada por el Espíritu Santo, no es una historia del pasado, sino un llamado vivo puesto en nuestras manos. THE SACRAMENTS



Preparación para los Sacramentos en la Iglesia Católica

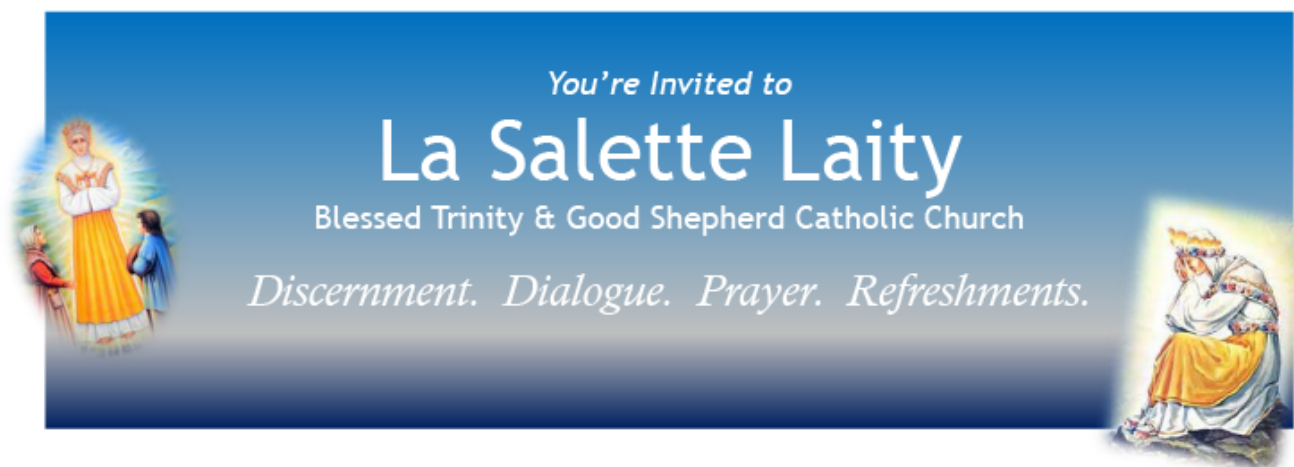

STEPS OF ST. PAUL & MEDJUGORJE

13 DAY TRAVEL ITINERARY

DAY 01 / OCT 06 ATLANTA OR HOUSTON / ATHENS

Depart Atlanta or Houston to Athens.

Day 02 / OCT 07 ATHENS

Upon arrival in Athens, you will be met and transferred to St. Dennis Cathedral for Mass then proceed to the hotel for dinner and overnight. Hotels **Athens Moxy**.

Day 03 / OCT 08 ATHENS / CORINTH / MYCENEA / ATHENS

You will be met with the guide and driver at the port, and then you will drive to Corinth. You will have a photo stop at the Corinth Canal. Visit the Ancient Corinth, the Excavations, and the Bema Seat. Lunch on their own. On to Mycenae, a mighty kingdom of ancient Greece and a military stronghold. See the Beehive Tombs, the Treasury of Atreus. Visit the remains of the ancient city, including the Lioness gate, the tomb of Agamemnon and the Palace. Return to Athens for dinner and overnight. Hotels **Athens Moxy**.

DAY 04 / OCT 09 ATHENS

Breakfast at the hotel and Holy Mass at St. Dennis Cathedral. You will continue with tour of Athens to include the Acropolis, Mars Hill, one of Paul's most important gospel presentations at the time of his visit to Athens during his second missionary journey (ACTS 17:16-34), It was where he addressed the religious idolatry of the Greeks. Visit the Parthenon at Acropolis and then see, the Agora, the ruins of the Ancient market place where Socrates questioned the market – goes about the understanding of the meaning of life. Then we will have city tour. We will see the Temple of Zeus, the Athenian Trilogy, the Hadrian Gate. See the Changing of the Guard at Syntagma Square and Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the former Royal Palace. Stop at the Plaka District. Rest of the day at leisure. Dinner and overnight. Hotels **Athens Moxy**.



Meteora

DAY 05 / OCT 10 ATHENS / LAVRION / MYKONOS

Transfer to the port of Piraeus and board your cruise ship for a 4-day, 3-night cruise of the Aegean Sea. It is said that three days on the Aegean gives one a true sense of Greece's layered history and a great respect for the God-given majesty of the Aegean's breath-taking islands. Holy Mass will be celebrated on board. The first port call is Mykonos, an island of beautiful beaches, secluded coves, dazzling white-washed houses, narrow paved streets and windmills which cover the island. Mykonos is also known for its churches - 365 of them dot the beautiful island. Return to the ship for dinner and overnight at sea.

DAY 06 / OCT 11 PATMOS / KUSADASI (EPHESUS)

You will have an early morning arrival at the port of Kusadasi (Ephesus). Disembark the ship and board your coach for a visit to the ancient city of Ephesus for a guided walking tour through one of the most magnificent excavated cities in the world. **We will visit the house of the Virgin Mary where we will have mass.** See the Odeon (concert hall), the Fountain of Trajan, the steam-heated Baths of Scolastika, the Temple of Hadrian and the latrines, the Library of Celsus and the Great Theatre of Ephesus where Paul preached. Return to your coach via the Arcadian Way where Marc Anthony and Cleopatra once rode in procession as newlyweds. Return to the ship for a short sail to the island of Patmos for a visit to the Monastery of St. John where the original gospel manuscript is on display. Then visit the Grotto of the Apocalypse where you see the silver niches in the wall that mark the pillow and ledge used as a desk by the author of the Book of Revelations as well as the three-fold crack made by the voice of God. Return to the ship for dinner and your overnight sailing to Crete.



Thessaloniki

DAY 07 / OCT 12 CRETE / SANTORINI

You will have an early morning arrival at the port of Heraklion (Crete) for a tour of Knossos, once the capital city of the prehistoric Minoan civilization. You will have Holy Mass at St. John the Baptist church and then enjoy a tour of the excavations of the Palace of King Minos and the surrounding area. Return to the ship for a short sail to the island of Santorini. Depart the ship by tender to Athenios Harbor to board your motor coach for an uphill drive to the Village of Oia. Enjoy free time exploring the city of Oia before returning to the ship for your overnight sail to Piraeus.

DAY 08 / OCT 13 ATHENS / DUBROVNIK / MEDJUGORJE

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Dubrovnik. Upon arrival, assistance and transfer to your hotel. Dinner and overnight stay in Medjugorje.

DAYS 9&10 / OCT 14-15 MEDJUGORJE (2 DAYS)

During our stay in peaceful Medjugorje, we will meet and share your faith with thousands of pilgrims from all over the world. Each morning at 10 there will assemble at St. James Church for the English language mass. Your local guide will accompany you during the next couple of days as you follow the same path up the Apparition Hill where the young visionaries first encountered Our Lady. Contemplate the inspired artistry of the bronze plaques depicting each mystery of the rosary as we climb Podbrdo Hill. Touch and pray before the cross, commemorating the spot where Mary appeared to the visionaries. See from afar and then climb Krizevac Mountain, where in 1933 the villagers built a 30' high cross on the anniversary of Jesus' crucifixion. Today, wooden crosses and bronze images line the path up the hill, representing the Stations of the Cross. Your guide will arrange a meeting with one of the visionaries in their own homes or a public place. In the evening, you can join the villagers and pilgrims for the evening Croation Mass and the Blessing of the Sick. Spend time in prayer and meditation at the most peaceful place in the whole world where our Blessed Mother first appeared to the children. You will return for dinner and overnight in Medjugorje from October 14-16, then depart to Dubrovnik for dinner and overnight on October 16th.

DAY 11 / OCT 16 DUBROVNIK / EXCURSION TO MONTENEGRO

After breakfast, we depart for the Republic of Montenegro. Head towards the mouth of the beautiful Bay of Kotor, the longest and deepest fjord in the Southern Europe. Enjoy a boat ride to Our Lady of the Rocks, one of two islets off the coast of Perast. The Roman Catholic Church is the largest building on the islet, with a museum attached to it. Upon return to the coast, we will stop at

Perast, an old charming coastal town. Visit city of Kotor where we visit St. Ozana Church. Rest of the day is at leisure before returning to your hotel for dinner and overnight in Dubrovnik.

DAY 12 / OCT 17 DUBROVNIK / SARAJEVO

Enjoy a walking tour of the Old City, beginning at Saint Blaise's Church dedicated to the Patron Saint of Dubrovnik. This baroque-style Church, constructed by Venetian architect Marino Gropelli in 1715, was styled after the Venetian Church, St. Mauritius. You will know that you have reached this masterpiece by its large staircase leading to the ornamented main portal and the large dome that decorates the roof. Continue to view the Gothic and Renaissance styled Rector's Palace, home to the History of Department Museum of Dubrovnik. Next, you will stroll by iconic Bell Tower Clock and Orlando's Column. To the left of the column, see the Sponza Palace. In the sixteenth century, members of the Academia Dei Concordi met on the first-floor hall to discuss literature. As a result, the palace is the most important cultural institution of Dubrovnik. Lastly, visit the Dominican and Franciscan Monasteries. The Dominican Monastery, strategically located at the most sensitive point of Dubrovnik's defense barriers. While at the Franciscan Monastery, you will have the opportunity to visit the pharmacy. The founding of this pharmacy was collaborative, serving the public and the needs of monks. This afternoon, enjoy lunch on your own at one of the many, small family-owned restaurants along the narrow streets. On to Sarajevo for dinner and overnight.
