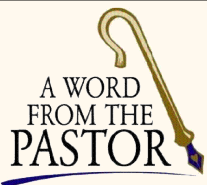

“A great prayer for life is urgently needed, a prayer which will rise up throughout the world. Let us therefore discover anew the humility and courage to pray and fast so that power from on high will break down the walls of lies and deceit.”

May these words inspire us to pray more deeply, witness more boldly, and love more faithfully in defense of the dignity of every human life.

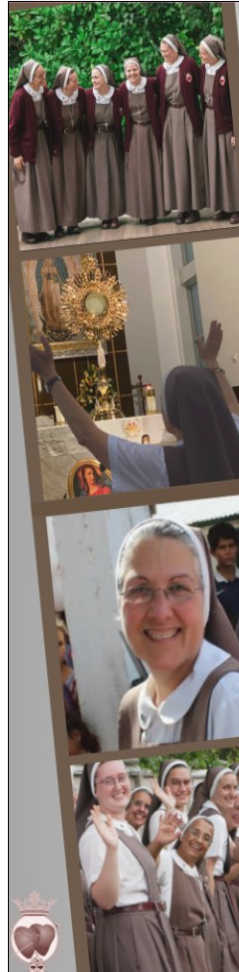
