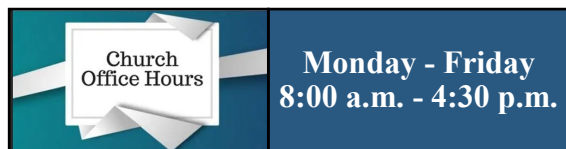

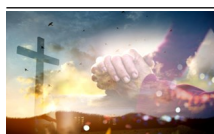

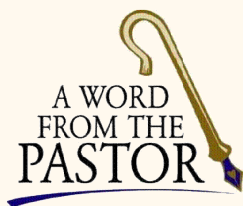

The following article ***“Where Faith Catches Fire”*** by **Alton J. Pelowski, Ed.** is reprinted from the Knights of Columbus national monthly magazine **Columbia**, Vol. 105, Number 60 (July /August 2025). We received permission from the publishers to share this article with the Catholic Community of Blessed Trinity Parish, Orlando. As Pastor, I found the article and its research so compelling, I urge you to read it carefully and let the content inform your faith to *catch fire*.

Where Faith Catches Fire

ON JUNE 16, the Pew Research Center published the results of a survey conducted earlier this year on Catholicism in the United States. It found that while 1 in 5 U.S. adults identify religiously as Catholic, only a relatively small minority follow the precepts of the Church: Just 28% attend Mass at least weekly, and 23% go to confession at least once a year. Another 9% of adults identify as “cultural Catholics,” and a similar number consider themselves “former Catholics” -whereas only 1.5% of U.S. adults are converts to the faith. These results are sobering and suggest that vibrant parish life is the exception rather than the rule.

Nevertheless, shining examples of - and opportunities for - renewal abound.

On Corpus Christi Sunday, just days after Pew reported its findings, the Eucharist was carried in procession for a mile through the streets of New Haven, Connecticut, beginning at St Mary's Church, the birthplace of the Order. Dozens of children took their place at the front - altar boys bearing a crucifix, candles, and bells; girls holding wicker baskets filled with rose petals, which they spread before the Blessed Sacrament. Also preceding the priest and canopied monstrance marched a Fourth Degree honor guard. Hundreds of parishioners followed. Some raised banners while others sang Eucharistic hymns in English, Spanish, Polish or Latin. The entire event was a beautiful witness - for onlookers and parishioners alike - to the unity of faith and of the Body of Christ.

One notable finding in the Pew study is that 47% of all U.S. adults - and 82% of Hispanic Americans - report a personal connection to the Catholic faith. Other key findings highlight that Mass attendance is closely tied to belief. Perhaps predictably, weekly Mass-goers are far more likely than others to say that having a personal relationship with Jesus Christ (91%) and receiving the Eucharist (83%) are essential to their faith. They are also nearly five times more likely to participate in other aspects of parish life.

The Pew survey was conducted in February, months before the election of the first U.S. born Pope, Leo XIV. Just two days before the study's release, Pope Leo delivered a video message to tens of thousands gathered in his hometown of Chicago. He invited listeners to recognize how God - Father, Son and Holy Spirit - is calling each of us into a life of communion. Citing the teachings of St. Augustine, he emphasized *“coming together in friendship, building up community,”* and added, *“we have to begin with our own lives, our own hearts.”*

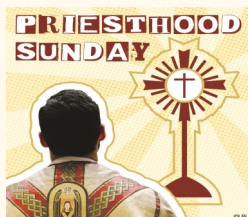
In the end, the survey results do more than quantify religious trends; they illuminate fundamental truths about evangelization. They confirm, for example, the pivotal role of the family and the parish in nurturing and passing on the faith. While faith is deeply personal, it does not grow in isolation. Strong Catholic families and strong parishes are essential to renewal. Blessed Michael McGivney had a keen understanding of this reality, as did his two younger brothers, who likewise became dynamic priests and pastors. Father McGivney's pastoral vision - first shaped by his own family and parish community - inspired him to found the Knights of Columbus, whose mission continues to be centered on building up the Church, beginning in our own parishes, our own families, and our own hearts.

Donde la fe se Prende en Fuego

El 16 de junio, el Centro de Investigación Pew publicó los resultados de una encuesta realizada a principios de este año sobre el catolicismo en los Estados Unidos. Se descubrió que, aunque 1 de cada 5 adultos en EE.UU. se identifica religiosamente como católico, solo una minoría relativamente pequeña sigue los preceptos de la Iglesia: apenas el 28% asiste a Misa al menos una vez por semana, y el 23% se confiesa al menos una vez al año. Otro 9% de adultos se identifican como “católicos culturales”, y un número similar se consideran “ex católicos”, mientras que solo el 1.5% de los adultos en EE.UU. son conversos a la fe. Estos resultados son preocupantes y sugieren que una vida parroquial es la excepción y no la regla. No obstante, abundan ejemplos brillantes y oportunidades de renovación.

El domingo de Corpus Christi, apenas unos días después de que Pew publicara sus hallazgos, la Eucaristía fue llevada en procesión durante una milla por las calles de New Haven, Connecticut, comenzando en la iglesia de St. Mary, lugar de nacimiento de la Orden. Decenas de niños ocuparon su lugar al frente: monaguillos llevando un crucifijo, cirios y campanas; niñas sosteniendo canastas de mimbre llenas de pétalos de rosas que esparcían delante del Santísimo Sacramento. También precediendo al sacerdote y a la custodia con dosel, marchaba una guardia de honor del Cuarto Grado. Cientos de feligreses la seguían. Algunos alzaban estandartes, mientras otros cantaban himnos eucarísticos en inglés, español, polaco o latín. Todo el evento fue un hermoso testimonio —tanto para los espectadores como para los feligreses— de la unidad de la fe y del Cuerpo de Cristo.

Un hallazgo notable del estudio de Pew es que el 47% de todos los adultos en EE.UU. —y el 82% de los hispanos— reportan una conexión personal con la fe católica. Otros resultados clave destacan que la asistencia a Misa está estrechamente ligada a la fe. Tal vez de manera previsible, quienes asisten a Misa semanalmente son mucho más propensos que otros a decir que tener una relación personal con Jesucristo (91%) y recibir la Eucaristía (83%) son esenciales para su fe. También tienen casi cinco veces más probabilidades de participar en otros aspectos de la vida parroquial.

La encuesta de Pew se realizó en febrero, meses antes de la elección del primer Papa nacido en Estados Unidos, León XIV. Apenas dos días antes de la publicación del estudio, el Papa León ofreció un mensaje en video a decenas de miles reunidos en su ciudad natal de Chicago. Invitó a los oyentes a reconocer cómo Dios —Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo— nos llama a cada uno a una vida de comunión. Citando las enseñanzas de San Agustín, enfatizó *“reunirse en amistad, edificar la comunidad”*, y añadió: *“tenemos que empezar con nuestra propia vida, con nuestro propio corazón”*.

Al final, los resultados de la encuesta hacen más que cuantificar tendencias religiosas; iluminan verdades fundamentales sobre la evangelización. Confirman, por ejemplo, el papel fundamental de la familia y la parroquia en nutrir y transmitir la fe. Aunque la fe es profundamente personal, no crece en aislamiento. Las familias católicas fuertes y las parroquias fuertes son esenciales para la renovación. El Beato Michael McGivney comprendió bien esta realidad, al igual que sus dos hermanos menores, quienes también se convirtieron en sacerdotes y pastores dinámicos. La visión pastoral del Padre McGivney —formada primero por su propia familia y comunidad parroquial— lo inspiró a fundar a los Caballeros de Colón, cuya misión sigue centrada en edificar la Iglesia, comenzando en nuestras propias parroquias, en nuestras propias familias y en nuestros propios corazones.

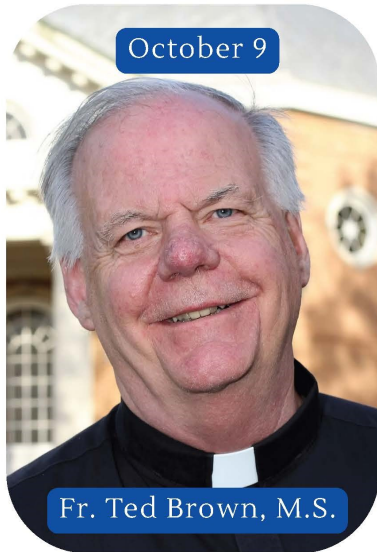

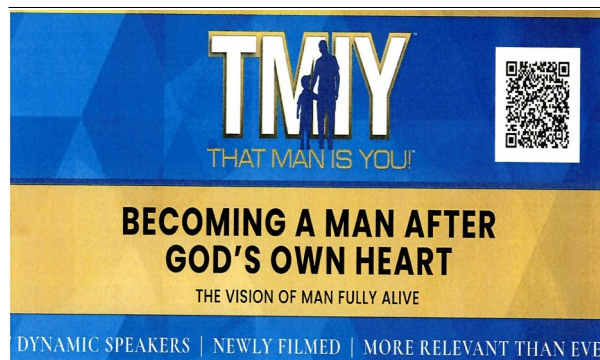

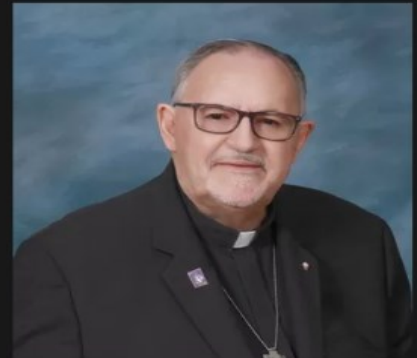
