









Second Sunday of Advent

Last weekend I invited us to renew our hearts and our hopes as we journey toward the wonder of Christmas—the birth of Jesus Christ, the One whom Isaiah names *Prince of Peace* and *God-Hero*. As we enter this Second Week of Advent, I would like to reflect on how generosity not only prepares a place for Christ within us, but also strengthens the future of our parish family.

Generosity That Builds the Kingdom

Advent teaches us that God is utterly generous—He gives us His Son. When we respond with generous hearts, we become instruments of that same love. Each gift we offer, *whether seen or unseen*, becomes a way Christ's presence reaches someone longing for hope. Your gifts of servant-discipleship have made a tremendous difference. El fin de semana pasado los invité a renovar nuestros corazones y nuestras esperanzas mientras caminamos hacia el asombro de la Navidad: el nacimiento de Jesucristo, a quien Isaías llama Príncipe de Paz y Dios-Héroe. Al entrar en esta Segunda Semana de Adviento, me gustaría reflexionar sobre cómo la generosidad no solo prepara un lugar para Cristo dentro de nosotros, sino que también fortalece el futuro de nuestra familia parroquial.

Generosidad que Construye el Reino

El Adviento nos enseña que Dios es totalmente generoso: Él nos da a Su Hijo. Cuando respondemos con corazones generosos, nos convertimos en instrumentos de ese mismo amor. Cada don que ofrecemos, ya sea visible u oculto, se convierte en un medio por el cual la presencia de Cristo llega a alguien que anhela esperanza. 


