







[You are] a light in darkness to the upright.

Today's scripture readings place before us a powerful and personal truth: God has given us freedom—and with it, responsibility. **Sirach** reminds us plainly, “*No one does he command to act unjustly; to none does he give license to sin*” (Sirach 15:20). Before each of us stand two paths: life or death, good or evil, God's way or our own. God honors the choice we make, and we receive what we choose.

In the **Gospel from Matthew**, Jesus continues the Sermon on the Mount, not by abolishing the Law, but by fulfilling it. He deepens its meaning and raises the stakes. Jesus is not interested in minimal obedience or outward compliance. He calls us to integrity of heart—a righteousness rooted in love of God and love of neighbor. This is a demanding fidelity, one that reaches into our intentions, attitudes, and daily choices.

Jesus invites us to a radical interior openness to God's will. Rather than a mindless rule-keeping, he calls for conversion of heart—where mercy, patience, forgiveness, and compassion shape our words and actions. **Psalm 119** echoes this vision, celebrating the beauty and harmony of God's law, while reminding us that God's wisdom often stretches beyond our understanding. This is where grace meets freedom, and where the Holy Spirit guides us when the path is unclear.

As Lent draws near, these readings ask us to pause and reflect honestly: What choices did I make today? Where did I choose life? Where did I choose myself instead of God? How will I prepare my heart to choose life more deliberately in the weeks ahead?

We conclude with the prayer of today's Opening Collect, which beautifully captures our hope:

O God, who teach us that you abide in hearts that are just and true, grant that we may be so fashioned by your grace as to become a dwelling pleasing to you. Through our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.



Eres luz en la oscuridad para los rectos.

Las lecturas bíblicas de hoy nos ponen delante una verdad poderosa y profundamente personal: Dios nos ha dado libertad y, con ella, responsabilidad. El libro del **Eclesiástico** nos lo recuerda con claridad: “*A nadie le ha mandado ser impío y a nadie le ha dado permiso de pecar*” (Eclo 15,20). Ante cada uno de nosotros se abren dos caminos: vida o muerte, bien o mal, el camino de Dios o el nuestro. Dios respeta la elección que hacemos, y recibimos aquello que elegimos.

En el **Evangelio según San Mateo**, Jesús continúa el Sermón de la Montaña, no para abolir la Ley, sino para llevarla a su plenitud. Profundiza su sentido y eleva la exigencia. A Jesús no le interesa una obediencia mínima ni un simple cumplimiento exterior. Nos llama a la integridad del corazón: una justicia enraizada en el amor a Dios y al prójimo. Es una fidelidad exigente, que alcanza nuestras intenciones, actitudes y decisiones cotidianas.

Jesús nos invita a una apertura interior radical a la voluntad de Dios. Más que un cumplimiento de normas, nos llama a una conversión del corazón, donde la misericordia, la paciencia, el perdón y la compasión modelan nuestras palabras y nuestras acciones. El **Salmo 119** hace eco de esta visión, celebrando la belleza y la armonía de la ley de Dios, y recordándonos que la sabiduría divina muchas veces supera nuestra comprensión. Aquí es donde la gracia se encuentra con la libertad, y donde el Espíritu Santo nos guía cuando el camino no es claro.

A medida que se acerca la Cuaresma, estas lecturas nos invitan a detenernos y reflexionar con honestidad: ¿Qué decisiones tomé hoy? ¿Dónde elegí la vida? ¿Dónde me elegí a mí mismo en lugar de a Dios? ¿Cómo prepararé mi corazón para elegir la vida de manera más consciente en las semanas que vienen?

Concluimos con la oración de la Colecta de hoy, que expresa bellamente nuestra esperanza:

Oh Dios, que enseñas que habitas en los corazones justos y sinceros, concédenos, por tu gracia, ser formados de tal manera que lleguemos a ser una morada agradable a ti. Por nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Amén.

La invitación de esta semana:

- Dedicar unos momentos cada día a examinar tus decisiones, preguntándote dónde estuvo Dios presente y cómo respondiste.
- Comienza a discernir una práctica cuaresmal que te ayude a elegir la vida con mayor intención, y un hábito que tal vez necesites dejar para seguir a Cristo con mayor fidelidad.





Fasting: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

Almsgiving: The foundational call of Christians to charity is a frequent theme of the Gospels. During Lent, we are asked to focus more intently on "almsgiving," which means donating money or goods to the poor and performing other acts of charity. As one of the three pillars of Lenten practice, almsgiving is "a witness to fraternal charity" and "a work of justice pleasing to God." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 2462).

Ayuno: El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días obligatorios de ayuno y abstinencia para los católicos. Además, los viernes de Cuaresma son días obligatorios de abstinencia. Para los miembros de la Iglesia Católica Latina, las normas sobre el ayuno son obligatorias desde los 18 años hasta los 59 años de edad. Cuando se ayuna, se permite a una persona comer una comida completa, así como dos comidas más pequeñas que juntas no sean iguales a una comida completa. Las normas sobre la abstinencia de carne son vinculantes para los miembros de la Iglesia Católica Latina a partir de los 14 años de edad.

Limosna: El llamado fundamental de los cristianos a la caridad es un tema frecuente en los Evangelios. Durante la Cuaresma, se nos pide que nos concentremos más intensamente en la "limosna", que significa donar dinero o bienes a los pobres y realizar otros actos de caridad. Como uno de los tres pilares de la práctica cuaresmal, la limosna es "un testimonio de caridad fraterna" y "una obra de justicia agradable a Dios" (Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, n. 2462).






