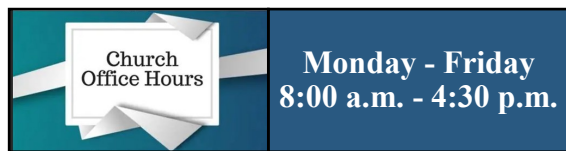

A WORD FROM THE PASTOR



On this Second Sunday of Easter — **Divine Mercy Sunday** — we are drawn again into the very heart of the Resurrection through the **Gospel of John (20:19–31)**. The scene is familiar: the apostles, fearful and uncertain, are gathered behind locked doors. Their fear is understandable after all they had witnessed — the suffering and death of the One they had come to believe was the Son of God and Savior.

Into that fear, the Risen Christ enters — not with reproach, not with anger — not with an extraordinary gift: **“Peace be with you.”** These are His first words. Not condemnation, but peace. Not vengeance, but mercy. In this moment, Jesus reveals that the victory of the Resurrection is not about power over others, but about love poured out for others. He sends them forth not as judges, but as **ambassadors of reconciliation**, entrusted with mercy and forgiveness.

Then, in a deeply intimate gesture, Jesus **breathes on them**. This recalls the very beginning of creation, when God breathed life into humanity. Now, in the new creation of the Resurrection, Christ breathes His Spirit upon His disciples. That same Spirit has been given to each of us — most especially in our Baptism and strengthened in Confirmation — calling us to new life, mission and servant-discipleship.

From this encounter, everything begins to change. Fear gives way to courage. Doubt begins to open into faith. The apostles who once hid behind locked doors will soon become bold witnesses to the world.

And then there is Thomas.

So often remembered for his doubt, Thomas is perhaps the most relatable of all the apostles. He desires not blind belief, but a personal encounter. And when that encounter comes, his response is extraordinary: **“My Lord and my God!”** In that moment, Thomas makes one of the most profound professions of faith in all of Scripture — **recognizing not only that Jesus is risen, but that He is truly Lord and God.**

Jesus responds with words meant not only for Thomas, but for every one of us: **“Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed.”**

That blessing is now ours; meant for us from this moment on.

Like Thomas, we may wrestle with doubts. Like the apostles, we may experience fear, uncertainty, or hesitation in faith. Yet we are invited into that same transforming encounter with the Risen Christ — a relationship not built on sight alone, but on trust, surrender, and love.

Throughout history, countless saints have come to this kind of living faith through powerful moments of conversion — Saint Francis of Assisi, Saint Martin of Tours, St. Teresa Benedicta, and so many others—each discovering in Christ a mercy and a truth that changed everything.

On this **Divine Mercy Sunday**, we are reminded that this same mercy and truth are offered to us. The Risen Jesus stands before us — not behind locked doors, but at the door of our hearts—offering peace, forgiveness, and new life.

If there is doubt, bring it.

If there is fear, name it.

If there is distance, close it.

If there is hope, share it.

Trust in Jesus. Surrender to His mercy. Believe — and you will discover a joy that nothing else can give. “Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed.” May that blessing be alive in each of us today.

En este Segundo Domingo de Pascua — **Domingo de la Divina Misericordia** — somos nuevamente atraídos al corazón mismo de la Resurrección a través del **Evangelio de Juan (20:19–31)**. La escena es familiar: los apóstoles, llenos de miedo e incertidumbre, están reunidos a puerta cerrada. Su temor es comprensible después de todo lo que habían presenciado — el sufrimiento y la muerte de Aquel en quien habían llegado a creer como el Hijo de Dios y Salvador.

MENSAJE DEL PASTOR



En medio de ese miedo, el Cristo Resucitado entra — no con reproche, no con enojo — sino con un don extraordinario: **“La paz esté con ustedes”**. Estas son Sus primeras palabras. No condena, sino paz. No venganza, sino misericordia. En este momento, Jesús revela que la victoria de la Resurrección no se trata de poder sobre otros, sino de amor derramado por los demás. Los envía no como jueces, sino como embajadores de reconciliación, confiándoles la misericordia y el perdón.

Luego, en un gesto profundamente íntimo, Jesús **sopla sobre ellos**. Esto nos recuerda el comienzo mismo de la creación, cuando Dios sopló vida en la humanidad. Ahora, en la nueva creación de la Resurrección, Cristo sopla Su Espíritu sobre Sus discípulos. Ese mismo Espíritu nos ha sido dado a cada uno de nosotros — especialmente en nuestro Bautismo y fortalecido en la Confirmación — llamándonos a una vida nueva, a la misión y al discipulado en servicio.

A partir de este encuentro, todo comienza a cambiar. El miedo da paso al valor. La duda comienza a abrirse a la fe. Los apóstoles que antes se escondían tras puertas cerradas pronto se convertirán en testigos valientes ante el mundo.

Y luego está Tomás.

Con frecuencia recordado por su duda, Tomás es quizá el más cercano a nuestra experiencia de todos los apóstoles. Él no desea una fe ciega, sino un encuentro personal. Y cuando ese encuentro sucede, su respuesta es extraordinaria: **“¡Señor mío y Dios mío!”**. En ese momento, Tomás hace una de las profesiones de fe más profundas de toda la Escritura — **reconociendo no solo que Jesús ha resucitado, sino que verdaderamente es Señor y Dios**.

Jesús responde con palabras dirigidas no solo a Tomás, sino a cada uno de nosotros: **“Dichosos los que creen sin haber visto”**.

Esa bienaventuranza ahora es nuestra; está destinada a nosotros desde este momento.

Como Tomás, podemos luchar con dudas. Como los apóstoles, podemos experimentar miedo, incertidumbre o hesitación en la fe. Sin embargo, estamos invitados a ese mismo encuentro transformador con Cristo Resucitado — una relación que no se basa solo en ver, sino en confiar, entregarse y amar.

A lo largo de la historia, innumerables santos han llegado a esta fe viva a través de poderosos momentos de conversión — San Francisco de Asís, San Martín de Tours, Santa Teresa Benedicta, y tantos otros — cada uno descubriendo en Cristo una misericordia y una verdad que lo cambiaron todo.

En este **Domingo de la Divina Misericordia**, se nos recuerda que esa misma misericordia y verdad se nos ofrecen a nosotros. El Jesús Resucitado está ante nosotros — no detrás de puertas cerradas, sino a la puerta de nuestro corazón — ofreciendo paz, perdón y vida nueva.

Si hay duda, tráela.

Si hay miedo, nómbralo.

Si hay distancia, acórtala.

Si hay esperanza, compártela.

Confía en Jesús. Entrégate a Su misericordia. Cree — y descubrirás una alegría que nada ni nadie puede dar.

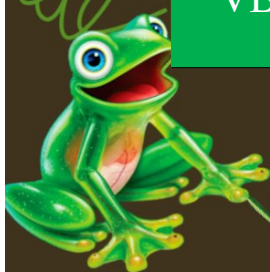
