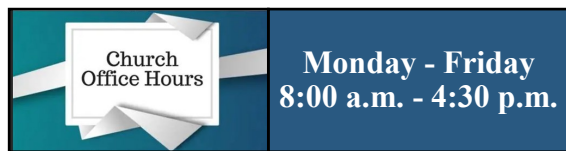

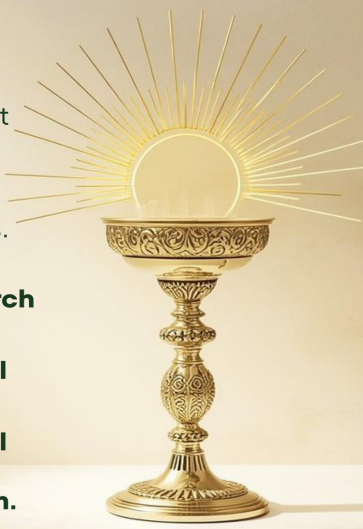

A WORD FROM THE PASTOR



When we believe it, we will see it.

On this Third Sunday of Easter, the Gospel invites us to walk alongside the two disciples on the road to Emmaus — a journey that begins in disappointment and ends in transformation. On the very day of the Resurrection, they are leaving Jerusalem discouraged, their hopes shattered, their expectations unmet. They had believed that Jesus would be “the one to redeem Israel,” yet the Cross seemed to have silenced that promise.

Their experience is not unfamiliar. How often do we carry our own burdens — plans that have failed, prayers that seem unanswered, hopes that feel lost? Like those first disciples, we can find ourselves trying to make sense of God’s ways, caught between what we expected and what has unfolded.

Yet it is precisely there, in that space of confusion and discouragement, that the Risen Christ draws near.

Jesus walks with them. He listens patiently to their story. He enters into their human experience — not with judgment, but with understanding. Then, gently and deliberately, He begins to open the Scriptures, revealing a deeper truth: that suffering is not the end, but part of God’s saving plan. Their hearts begin to burn within them as they glimpse a new way of seeing—one shaped not by disappointment, but by divine promise.

It is in the breaking of the bread that their eyes are finally opened.

This moment is more than recognition — it is revelation. In this simple, sacred act, they encounter the living Christ. What was once despair is now transformed into conviction and mission. The One they thought was gone is alive, present, and offering Himself to them. The Eucharist becomes the sign that confirms everything: His love, His sacrifice, His victory over death.

The Emmaus story is often called a “Gospel within the Gospel” because it mirrors our own journey of faith. We, too, can be slow to understand, selective in what we accept, and hesitant to embrace the full mystery of Christ — especially when it involves suffering, sacrifice, or surrender. Yet Jesus never abandons us. He meets us where we are, walks with us, and patiently leads us deeper into truth.

This same pattern of transformation is echoed in the First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles, where Peter boldly proclaims the risen Christ, and in the Second Reading, reminding us that we were ransomed not with perishable things, but with the precious blood of Christ. The disciples who once feared now speak with courage; those who once doubted now believe with conviction.

Is this not the same grace at work in us?

Each time we gather for the Eucharist, we are invited into that same encounter. Christ speaks to us in His Word. He nourishes us in the breaking of the bread. He enters our struggles, our questions, our lives — and transforms them from within. Slowly, patiently, He helps us set aside our limited expectations and opens us to a greater vision: the Paschal Mystery, where death gives way to life, and sorrow is turned into hope.

The journey to Emmaus reminds us that we are never alone. Even when we do not recognize Him, Christ walks beside us. And in the Eucharist, our eyes are opened once more — to see Him, to receive Him, and to be sent forth renewed.

May our hearts burn within us. May we recognize Him in the breaking of the bread. And may we, like those first disciples, rise with renewed faith to proclaim:

The Lord is truly risen—and He is with us still.

Cuando lo creemos, lo veremos.

En este Tercer Domingo de Pascua, el Evangelio nos invita a caminar junto a los dos discípulos en el camino a Emaús — un viaje que comienza en la decepción y termina en la transformación. En el mismo día de la Resurrección, ellos se van de Jerusalén desanimados, con sus esperanzas destrozadas y sus expectativas no cumplidas. Habían creído que Jesús sería “el que iba a redimir a Israel”, sin embargo, la Cruz parecía haber silenciado esa promesa.

MENSAJE DEL PASTOR



Su experiencia no nos es ajena. ¿Cuántas veces cargamos con nuestras propias preocupaciones — planes que han fracasado, oraciones que parecen no ser escuchadas, esperanzas que se sienten perdidas? Como aquellos primeros discípulos, podemos encontrarnos tratando de comprender los caminos de Dios, atrapados entre lo que esperábamos y lo que realmente ha sucedido.

Y es precisamente allí, en ese espacio de confusión y desaliento, donde Cristo Resucitado se acerca.

Jesús camina con ellos. Escucha pacientemente su historia. Entra en su experiencia humana — no con juicio, sino con comprensión. Luego, con suavidad y de manera deliberada, comienza a abrirles las Escrituras, revelando una verdad más profunda: que el sufrimiento no es el final, sino parte del plan salvador de Dios. Sus corazones comienzan a arder dentro de ellos al vislumbrar una nueva forma de ver — una formada no por la decepción, sino por la promesa divina.

Es en el rompimiento del pan donde finalmente se les abren los ojos.

Este momento es más que un reconocimiento — es una revelación. En este acto sencillo y sagrado, encuentran al Cristo vivo. Lo que antes era desesperación ahora se transforma en convicción y misión. Aquel a quien creían perdido está vivo, presente y ofreciéndose a ellos. La Eucaristía se convierte en el signo que lo confirma todo: su amor, su sacrificio, su victoria sobre la muerte.

La historia de Emaús es a menudo llamada un “Evangelio dentro del Evangelio” porque refleja nuestro propio camino de fe. También nosotros podemos ser lentos para entender, selectivos en lo que aceptamos y dudosos al abrazar plenamente el misterio de Cristo — especialmente cuando implica sufrimiento, sacrificio o entrega. Sin embargo, Jesús nunca nos abandona. Nos encuentra donde estamos, camina con nosotros y pacientemente nos conduce hacia la verdad.

Este mismo patrón de transformación se refleja en la Primera Lectura de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, donde Pedro proclama con valentía a Cristo resucitado, y en la Segunda Lectura, que nos recuerda que fuimos rescatados no con cosas perecederas, sino con la sangre preciosa de Cristo. Los discípulos que antes tenían miedo ahora hablan con valentía; los que dudaban ahora creen con convicción.

¿No es esta la misma gracia obrando en nosotros?

Cada vez que nos reunimos para la Eucaristía, somos invitados a ese mismo encuentro. Cristo nos habla en su Palabra. Nos alimenta en la fracción del pan. Entra en nuestras luchas, nuestras preguntas, nuestras vidas — y las transforma desde dentro. Poco a poco, con paciencia, nos ayuda a dejar de lado nuestras expectativas limitadas y nos abre a una visión mayor: el Misterio Pascual, donde la muerte da paso a la vida y el dolor se convierte en esperanza.

El camino a Emaús nos recuerda que nunca estamos solos. Incluso cuando no lo reconocemos, Cristo camina a nuestro lado. Y en la Eucaristía, nuestros ojos se abren una vez más — para verlo, para recibirlo y para ser enviados renovados.

Que nuestro corazón arda dentro de nosotros. Que lo reconozcamos en la fracción del pan. Y que nosotros, como aquellos primeros discípulos, nos levantemos con fe renovada para proclamar:

El Señor ha resucitado verdaderamente—y está con nosotros.

**Pope Leo XIV's Prayer Intentions
April - For priests in crisis**

Let us pray for priests going through moments of crisis in their vocation, that they may find the accompaniment they need and that communities may support them with understanding and prayer.

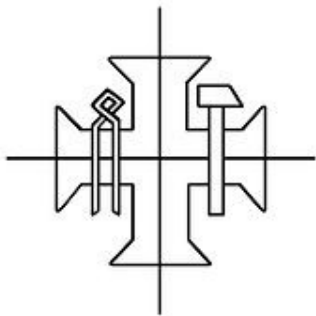

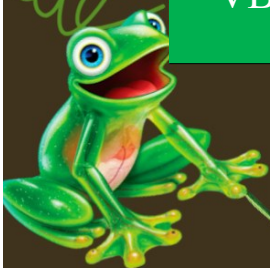
