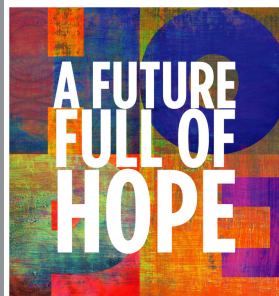

- Welcome Event for Fr. Dean at **St. Catherine on Saturday, August 7** after 5PM Mass.



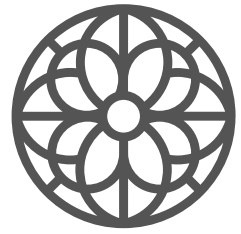
IMPORTANT COVID UPDATE

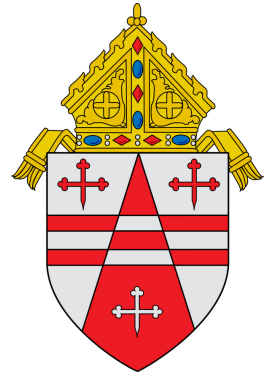

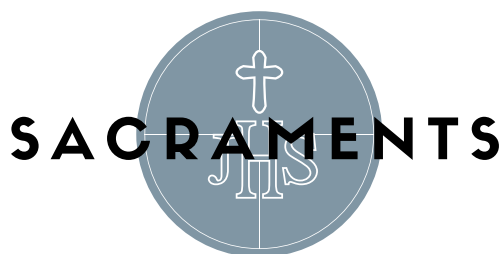
