



# **BAPTISM**



# Prior to the baptism, parents need to:

\*Fill out the baptismal registration form (You can download forms online or contact the parish office for a copy)

\*Provide a copy of the child's state-issued birth certificate

\*Have each godparent complete a godparent form \*Attend a baptism preparation class and ask the godparents to do the same. If individuals have attended the class previously (with in the last three years) this requirement is met.
