

BAPTISM

Prior to the baptism, parents need to:

*Fill out the baptismal registration form
(You can download forms online or contact the parish office for a copy)

- *Provide a copy of the child's state-issued birth certificate
- *Have each godparent complete a godparent form
- *Attend a baptism preparation class and ask the godparents to do the same. If individuals have attended the class previously (within the last three years) this requirement is met.
