



Join a small faith-sharing group for Lent

Before the pandemic, our two parishes had a number of small groups spread throughout the towns both parishes serve. Here is a chance to do this again. I will be hosting two small groups. Fridays, starting February 16, from 7 to 8:30 p.m., we will meet at the Slusser Senior Center in Contoocook to review the biblical readings for the coming Sunday. We will delve into Catholic issues and explore ways of practicing our Catholic faith

On Monday evenings, I will be hosting a small group at my residence, the parish rectory, at 246 Old West Hopkinton Road in Henniker. This group will explore principles of group spiritual direction. These will be training sessions in leading small Church groups and growing together in our Catholic faith.

How about starting a group in your own home, in a local library or other senior center, or in a local Christian Church? Using the Missalette, reading the biblical readings together, and sharing some insights, and ending the evening with groups of two people praying for one another's needs, is an easy framework to follow. Groups could also become Book clubs, with writings from Matthew Kelly, papal documents, or some other Catholic source. Please notify the parish office of the time and place your group plans to meet in the coming weeks of Lent.

Have you ever participated in a Catholic retreat weekend? by Father Marcel

Cursillo (pronounced Kur-see-yo) de Christianidad.....Spanish for "Short course in Christianity".....is a Catholic experience that a number of parishioners have attended in past years. I have served as a spiritual director on about 20 such weekends. Father Ray Ball from Concord will be spiritual director for the Men's Cursillo starting on the evening of March 7 through the afternoon of March 10. I will be serving ass spiritual director for the Women's Cursillo starting on the evening of April 18 through the afternoon of April 21. For the first time, these Cursillos will take place at a retreat house at Camp Sentinel in Tuftonburo, New Hampshire, on the eastern side of Lake Winnipesaukee.

Men's weekends are led by laymen, with a priest giving a couple of presentations and celebrating the sacraments. Women's weekends are led by laywomen with a priest giving a couple of presentations and celebrating the sacraments. There are talks and small groups. There are meals together, and comfortable sleeping quarters. The retreat house a modern heating system and full bathroom facilities. There is music and singing. There is laughter and prayer. There is silence and time for personal reflection.

Some people come out of these weekends on fire for their faith. Others gain new insights on how to live an authentic Catholic life. Others still are enriched by what they have learned over the years as they hear the message of the Gospel communicated in a different way. Please consider attending a Cursillo weekend.

GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

February 11, 2024



Recently I had a skin rash, and it was awful. (Please don't tell anyone.) I am embarrassed to admit that I didn't handle it well. Complaining, whining, begging for sympathy, and crying were my responses to the merciless itching and burning. In the aftermath, a silver lining emerged. I feel a new heartfelt sympathy for all those vexed with chronic skin problems. If you've ever had a seemingly unending skin problem, you know how that sympathy flows up from deep inside.

This gut-level compassion is something like what the Gospel describes in Jesus when the sore-covered leper says, "If you will it, you can make me clean." At this, just before the healing, Jesus was "moved with compassion." The Greek word used here is strong and earthy, closer to "his bowels and guts trembled with the deepest emotions of sadness, pity, and love." In Jesus, God heals our infirmities not from a divine distance but by learning what it *feels like* to be us. He acquires first-hand experience of what it costs us to be afflicted and still be faithful to God. He sympathizes with the burning, itching, and blistering of human existence in the deepest, first-hand way. To discover that is to touch Jesus' heart.

What in your life, right now, is breaking out like diseased skin? What is getting worse the more you try to soothe it? Perhaps only you feel it. Or maybe it's exposed to all. A bad habit, broken relationship, loneliness, fear of failure, self-hatred? Name it, and then find a way to bring it confidently to Jesus who will *feel what we are feeling*, and thereby heal us.
