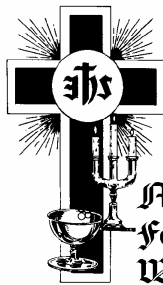

ADULT SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

If you or know of someone who has questions about becoming a Catholic, **now** is the time to consider making an appointment to speak with one of the team to see what the RCIA program has to offer. This process of conversion is one that involves inquiry and commitment to formation in the faith including becoming a part of the parish community. In addition we would like to bring to your attention the **Archdiocesan Adult Confirmation Program**. This is designed for PRACTICING adult Catholics over 18 years of age who for one reason or another had never received the sacrament of Confirmation but have been Baptized, received First Holy Communion and have been educated in the past through a religious education program. The program involves 8 sessions at a central diocesan location later in the year. However a letter from the pastor granting permission to participate in the program, and copies of Baptismal and First Communion certificates are required. Now is the time to begin to think about this important step and be ready to register at the appropriate time.
