



ADULT SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

At present we have one adult coming into the faith- who will be taking classes with our team this year. It is always wonderful to share the knowledge and classes in a group setting- maybe now is the time for someone you may know! If you are aware of a person who is looking to convert to our Catholic Faith (possibly a spouse or friend who has considered this recently) and feels they might want to learn more, encourage them to call for information and a meeting to find out how the process works. This process of conversion is one that involves inquiry and commitment to formation in the faith including becoming a part of the parish community.

In addition we would like to bring to your attention the **Archdiocesan Adult Confirmation Program**. This is designed for PRACTICING adult Catholics over 18 years of age who for one reason or another had never received the sacrament of Confirmation but have been Baptized, received First Holy Communion and have been educated in the past through a religious education program. The program involves 8 sessions at a central diocesan location later in the year. However a letter from the pastor granting permission to participate in the program, and copies of Baptismal and First Communion certificates are required. Now is the time to begin to think about this important step and be ready to register at the appropriate time.
