SOME RANDOM THOUGHTS FROM FR. B...

First things, first... Please let me thank everyone who took the time to come by to wish me a “Happy Birthday” last weekend. It is always nice when that happens and is also greatly appreciated. I spent the afternoon with my brother (whose birthday is the same day, four years later!). I also appreciate all your prayers and concerns for him in the last few months. He is back at *The Fountains* and going for PT there. He is doing well and is now beginning the rounds of follow-up doctor's visits. He met the neurosurgeon last week and the doctor agreed with the plan to wait on any surgery unless he develops any headaches or strange symptoms. So that hurdle is over with. He is very appreciative of your concern and prayers for him.

I have a favor to ask... Most of you are aware that due to the times we live in, churches can no longer be left open all day and all night. This is unfortunate but also quite necessary. Our practice has become that we lock the church after the last Mass each day and open it about 30 minutes before the first scheduled event of the day. Normally, I lock the front doors before I leave the back of the church and return to the sacristy. At times, there are still people praying or talking. Rather than rush them or make them feel like I am “tossing them out”, but to prevent me from forgetting to lock the church later I will lock it after the crowd has left, unless someone is moving towards the door. I try to let them know that the doors are locked and they will need to use one of the other exits: by the cry room and from the hall and kitchen, all of which are locked but can be opened from the inside by pushing the “panic bars”. Unfortunately, sometimes people will just unlock the front doors to let themselves out which leaves the church unlocked and unsecured for the remainder of the day—and the night. Therefore, the favor...please, if the main doors are already locked when you do leave, *please do not unlock them...leave them locked and use one of the other exits*. In my first assignment in Brewster, I once walked into a church that had been robbed during the night. That is one experience I really hope I'll never have to re-live. With your understanding and cooperation, please God, I won't have to.


A reminder: the Cardinal's Appeal really is coming... In all my years as a priest, I have always tried a gentle approach when asking for your help. This year, that gentle approach almost caused me to forget it, especially since the Appeal office never got my letter out to you which I gave them to mail before Lent began. For some reason, when we realized this and planned to send it out just after Easter, that never happened either. *I have been promised that you should be getting it this week*. I ask that you read it over and prayerfully consider lending your support to this year's appeal. The help of those who have been unable or a bit unwilling to contribute in the past is really needed this year since many of us are already paying off our pledge from *Renew + Rebuild* and may not be able to be as helpful as we have been in the past. Just as a reminder, if we reach our goal, then 60% of what comes in “over goal” will remain in the parish for our use. Please prayerfully consider your response to my letter ***if it EVER gets to your mailbox!!!!***

One final thought... Next Sunday is the Feast of *Corpus Christi (the Body and the Blood of Christ)*. There will be an announcement in next week's bulletin about a summer program on this very important doctrine of our faith. Normally, we don't schedule very much during the summer because so many are on vacation, but this year we thought that not everyone goes away for the whole summer, so maybe we should give a program a try for those who ARE home. Next week we will give you the details and see if there is enough interest.
