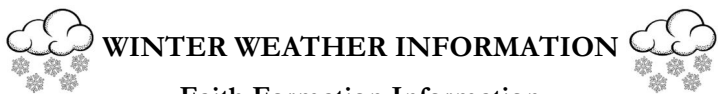
### **FELLOWSHIP**
